## Humanities in all programs

The presence (Extensively, Moderately or A little) of Humanities in programs offered in 2019-20 stayed almost the same, 72\%, compared to $73 \%$ the previous year. The most common fields of Humanities taught in programs that included the division were: Writing ( $98 \%$ ), History ( $47 \%$ ), and Literature ( $42 \%$ ).
