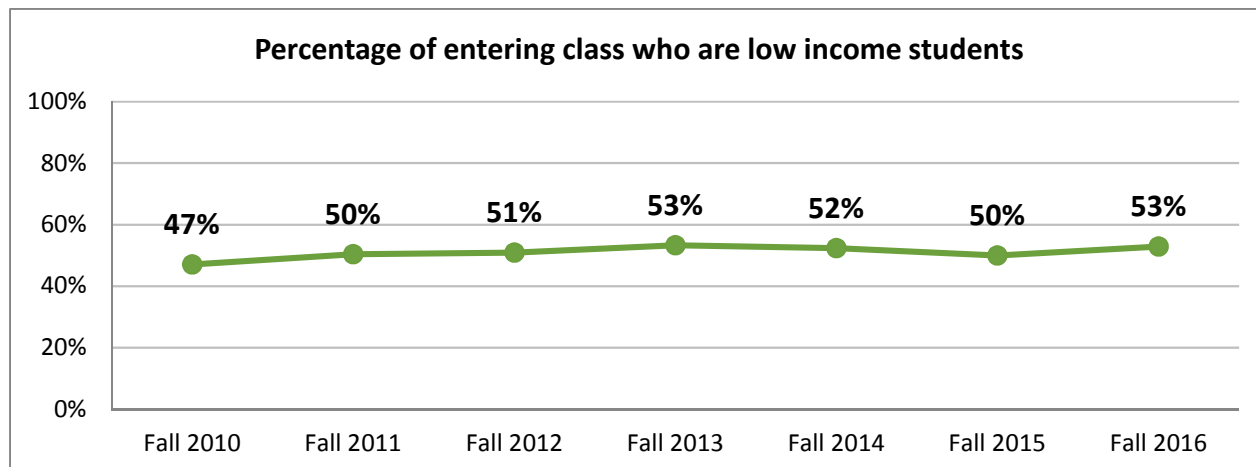


**Core Theme 4: Diversity and Equity****Objective 3: Student Access and Success (Maintain)**

**Low-income** is defined according to the federal low income standard, which is  $\leq 150\%$  of federal poverty level.

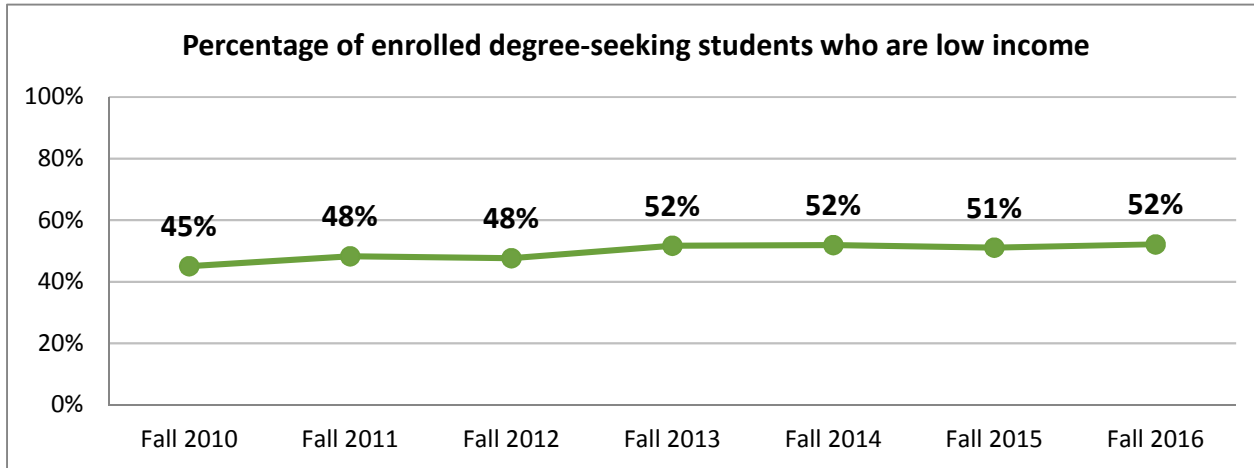

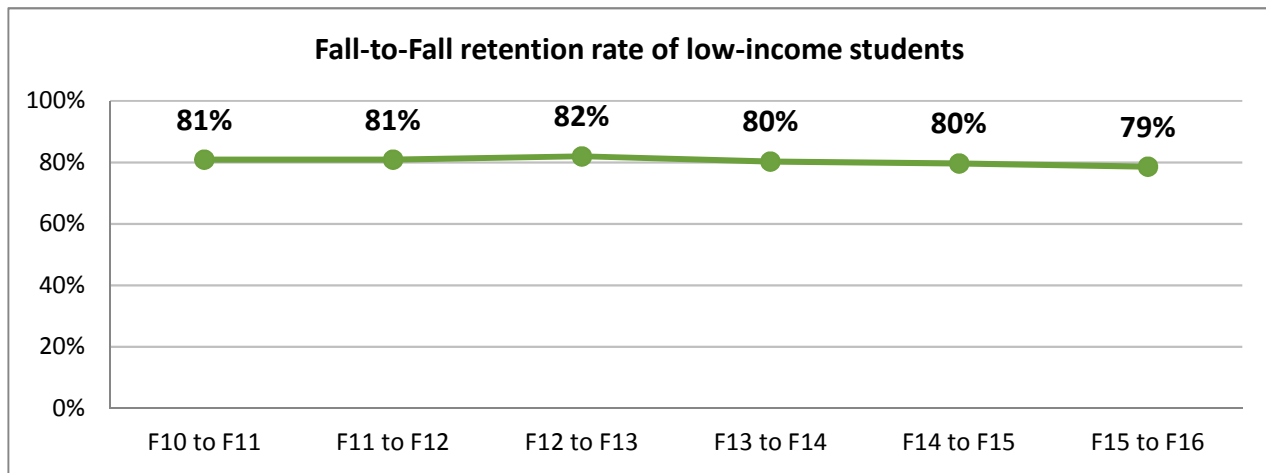

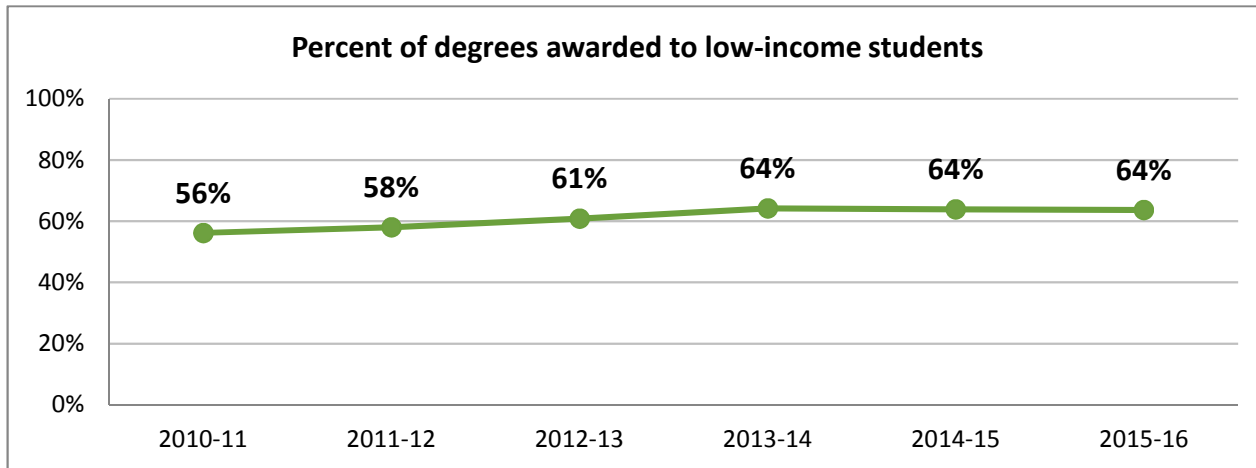
