## International Student Application Checklist

You are a **Freshman Applicant** if you have completed only high school or have earned fewer than 40 transferable quarter credits at any college or university.

You are a **Transfer Applicant** if you have attended any college or university after high school and earned more than 40 transferable quarter credits.

- Complete the application for admission and pay the \$50 (U.S.) non-refundable application fee.
  - If you are a *Freshman Applicant*, ask your secondary school to send your official transcript to Evergreen's Office of Admissions. If you have attended any college or university, ask the school to send your official transcript to the Office of Admissions.
  - If you are a *Transfer Applicant*, ask your previous college or university to send your official transcript to Evergreen's Office of Admissions.
- Provide certified translations of all documents that are not in English.
- Submit one of the following as proof of English language proficiency:
  - Minimum iBT TOEFL score – 79
  - Minimum IELTS score – 6
  - Completion of English 101 and English 102 with a B (3.0) at a U.S. school
  - Completion of level B-2-3 at an EF Language Center
- Submit **optional** Application Statement. Please answer the following question:

What experiences (academic, service, or professional) have prepared you for college studies at Evergreen?
