Registration for seniors starts Monday, March 13, juniors on Tuesday, March 14, sophomores on Wednesday, March 15, freshmen on Thursday, March 16.

Popular programs and classes can and do fill in a matter of minutes, so it's crucial that you be at a computer, ready to register at 8:00 am on your registration day!

Registration tips from Academic and Career Advising:

- Review the [How to Register](#) information on the [Registration and Records](#) website.
- Check your time ticket in my.evergreen.edu to verify your class level and what day you register.
- Make sure that you're using the correct CRN number for your class level.
- Check to ensure you don't have any holds on your account. *You should do this at least 2 days ahead of your registration date.* If you do, they'll show up in a yellow "To Do" box on the right side of your main my.evergreen.edu screen.
- Write down the CRN numbers for several options. If you don't get into your first choice, [waitlist yourself](#) and immediately register for your second choice.

Have questions or unsure what to take? Academic and Career Advising can help!

Starting on Monday, March 13, and running through Friday, March 17, Academic Advisors will be taking drop-ins only, 9:00 am-noon and 1:00-5:00 pm (4:00 pm on Fridays).

The presentation is part of celebrating **TRiO's 40th year at Evergreen**, and will (we hope) offer a candid and real look at our students' experiences at Evergreen!



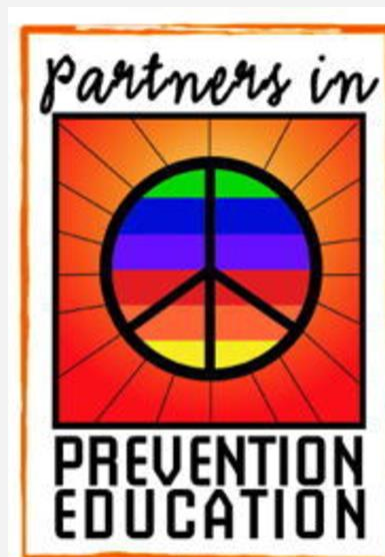
