




 Experience of First-time, First-year Students

Participation in Community and On-campus Activities

Students were asked about their participation in community activities during the year. The chart below shows activities sorted from highest to lowest mean response. More than 70% of first-time, first-year respondents (74.1%) indicated that they had attended lectures, panels, or conferences on campus "A Little" or more, and 69.7% indicated that they had watched or participated in theatrical or musical performances on campus. More than half had participated "A Little," "Some," or "A Lot" on all items except participating in community service or volunteer work. A total of 34.3% indicated that they had participated in community service or volunteer work during the year.
