





Responses of Olympia Campus Students

Participation in Community Activities

Students were asked about their participation in community activities during the year. The chart below shows activities sorted from highest to lowest mean response. More than 70% of students (72.1%) indicated that they had attended lectures, panels, or conferences on campus. A total of 64.3% had viewed or participated in art exhibits/shows on campus. More than half (52.5%) had watched or participated in theatrical or musical performances on campus. A total of 47.4% of Olympia campus respondents participated in community service or volunteer work and 43.2% had participated in a student activity group/club.
