






Responses of Students in the Tacoma Program

Participation in Community and On-campus Activities

Students were asked about their participation in community activities during the year. The chart below shows activities sorted from highest to lowest mean response. More than 70% of Tacoma respondents (73.7%) indicated that they had attended lectures, panels, or conferences on campus from "A Little" to "A Lot," and 68.4% indicated that they had participated in community service or volunteer work. Half of the Tacoma respondents indicated that they had participated in a student activity group/club.
