Types of Classes Taken During Academic Year 05-06

Students were asked to indicate the kinds of classes they took during Academic Year 05-06. The greatest proportion of respondents enrolled in Tribal Programs indicated that they had taken at least one Evening and Weekend part-time program (75.9%). About 14% indicated that they had taken at least one day-time, full-time program. Some respondents also indicated participation in 2-6 credit Evening and Weekend Studies courses, independent learning contracts, internships, and Extended Education Classes. None of the respondents in the Tribal Programs indicated that they had taken a Leisure Education class.

Evening and Weekend part-time program(s) (8-12 credits per program)	75.9%
Day-time, full-time program(s)	13.8%
Evening and Weekend course(s) (2-6 credits per course)	10.3%
Independent Learning Contract(s)	10.3%
Internship(s)	6.9%
Class(es) through Extended Education	6.9%
Class(es) through Leisure Education	0.0%

*Percentages do not add up to 100% because students could indicate as many different types of programs/courses as they took during AY 05-06.
