





Tribal: Reservation-based/Community-Determined Programs

Participation in Community and On-campus Activities

Students were asked about their participation in community activities. The chart below shows activities sorted from highest to lowest mean response. More than half of the respondents enrolled in Tribal Programs indicated that they participated "A Little" to "A Lot" in community service or volunteer work (62%), a student activity group or club (55.1%), and in attending lectures, panels or conferences on campus (55.1%).
