

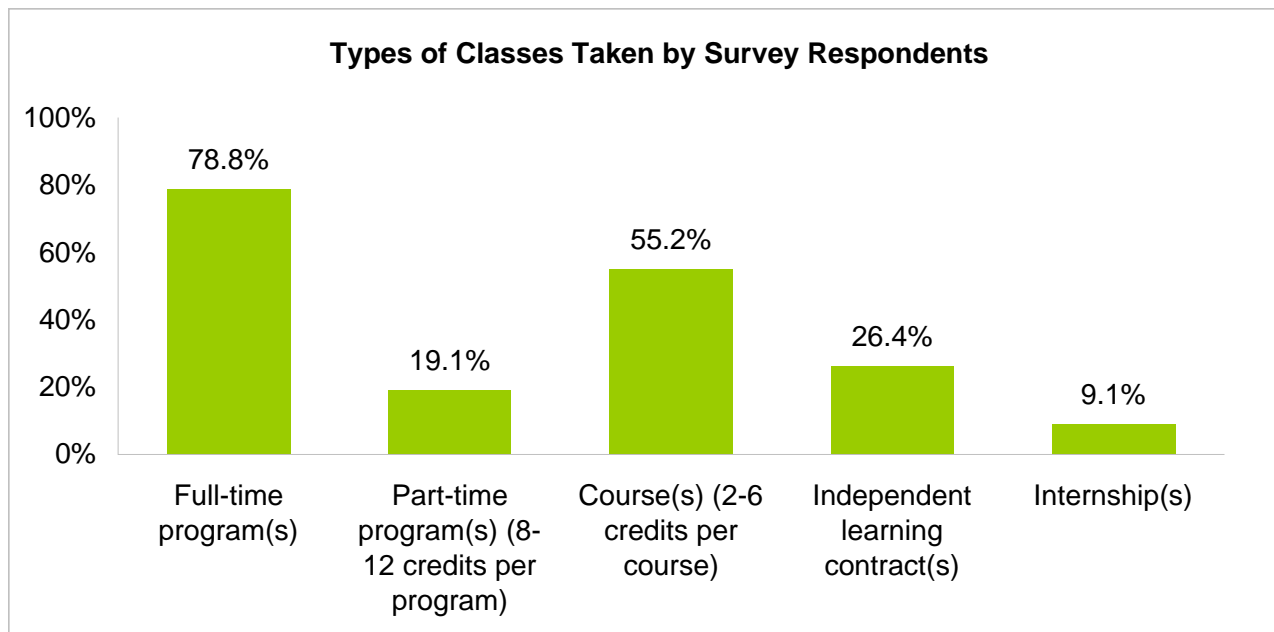

Responses of Olympia Campus Students

Types of Classes Taken by Survey Respondents (Academic Year 07-08)

Using quarterly enrollment data, the kinds of classes survey respondents took during Academic Year 07-08 were analyzed. Almost 80% of Olympia campus respondents (78.8%) had taken at least one full-time program. Over 55% had taken a course (2-6 credits per course.) A total of 19.1% of the Olympia campus respondents had taken a part-time program (8-12 credits per program), and 26.4% had taken an independent learning contract. Of Olympia campus respondents, 9.1% had taken an internship.

Independent learning contract(s)	26.4%

*Percentages do not add up to 100% because students could indicate as many different types of programs/courses as they had taken in a single year.



Combinations of Classes Taken During the Year (In Mutually Exclusive Categories)

In order to understand the combinations of class types that respondents had taken in one year, respondents were grouped into categories based on the kinds of classes they took in the 2007-008 school year. The largest percentage of respondents took daytime programs only (32.4%) with the next largest group taking a combination of three or more types of classes (23.3%). Nineteen percent of respondents took Full-time programs and courses. In the table below, Independent study refers to contracts and internships.
