### Ability to Enroll in First Choice of Academic Offerings

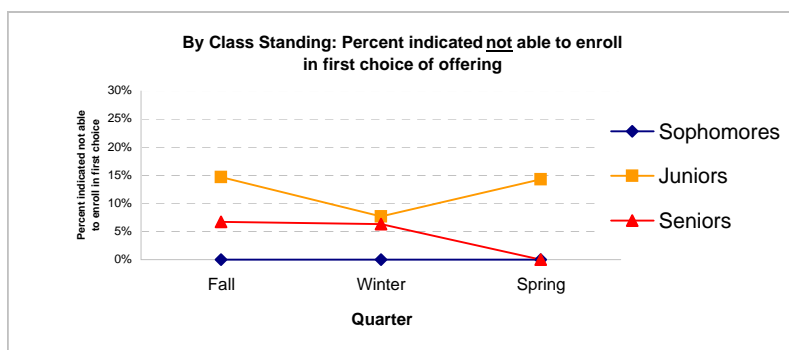
Students were asked to indicate whether they were able to enroll in their first choice of academic offerings. The percent of Tacoma campus respondents who indicated that they could not enroll in their first choice of academic offerings ranged from 7.0% in winter 2008 to 11.3% in fall 2007.

*Were you able to enroll in your first choice of offering...?*

\*Students were recoded as missing if they said that they transferred in winter or spring quarter, or were otherwise not enrolled for that particular quarter.

The following chart shows the percentage by class standing of Tacoma campus respondents unable to enroll in their first-choice offering as of spring quarter 2008. All sophomores reported being able to get into their first choice of offering. Juniors had the highest percentage of respondents unable to enroll in their first choice (ranging from 7.7% in winter to 14.7% in fall).
