Primary Area of Study or Concentration

Students were asked to describe their primary field(s) of study or concentration at Evergreen. The open-ended responses to this question were coded into the Classification for Instructional Programs (CIP) 2000 codes. Some respondents wrote in more than one field of study, so percentages do not add up to 100%. The greatest proportion of Olympia campus respondents indicated an interest in Public Administration and Social Service Professions (45.1%), Social Sciences (23.5%), Psychology (21.6%), and Liberal Arts and Sciences, General Studies and Humanities (17.6%).

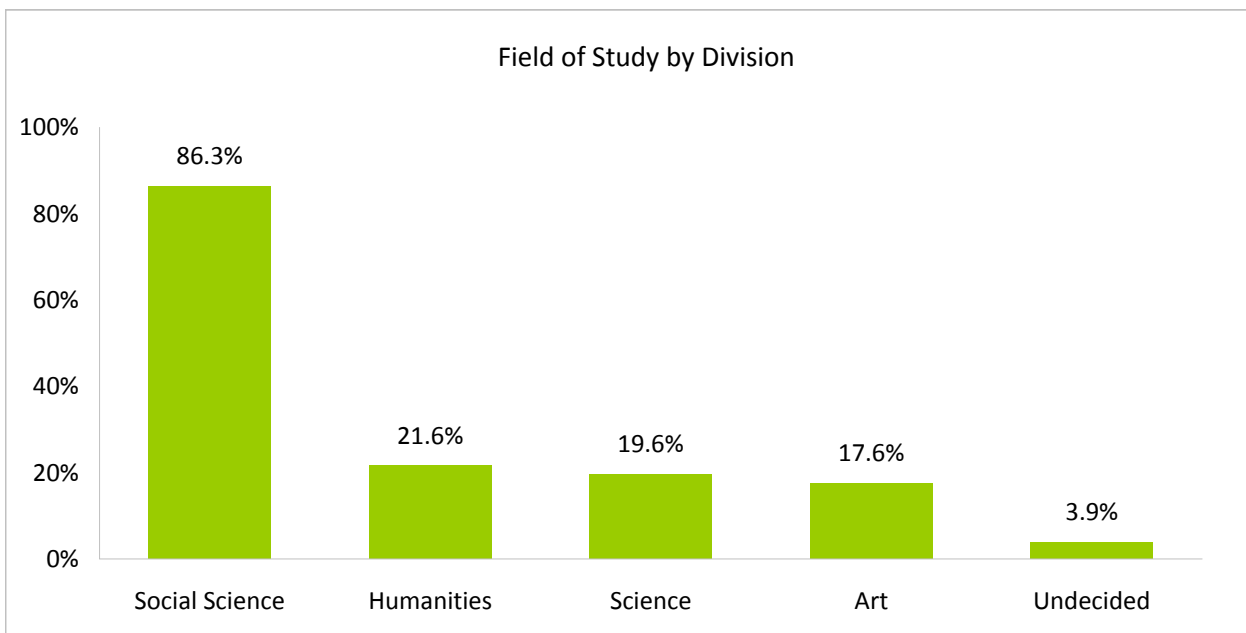
Primary Area of Study or Concentration - Divisional Analysis

The greatest proportion of Olympia campus respondents indicated a Social Science as a primary field of study (86.3%), followed by Humanities (21.6%), Science (19.6%), and Art (17.6%). 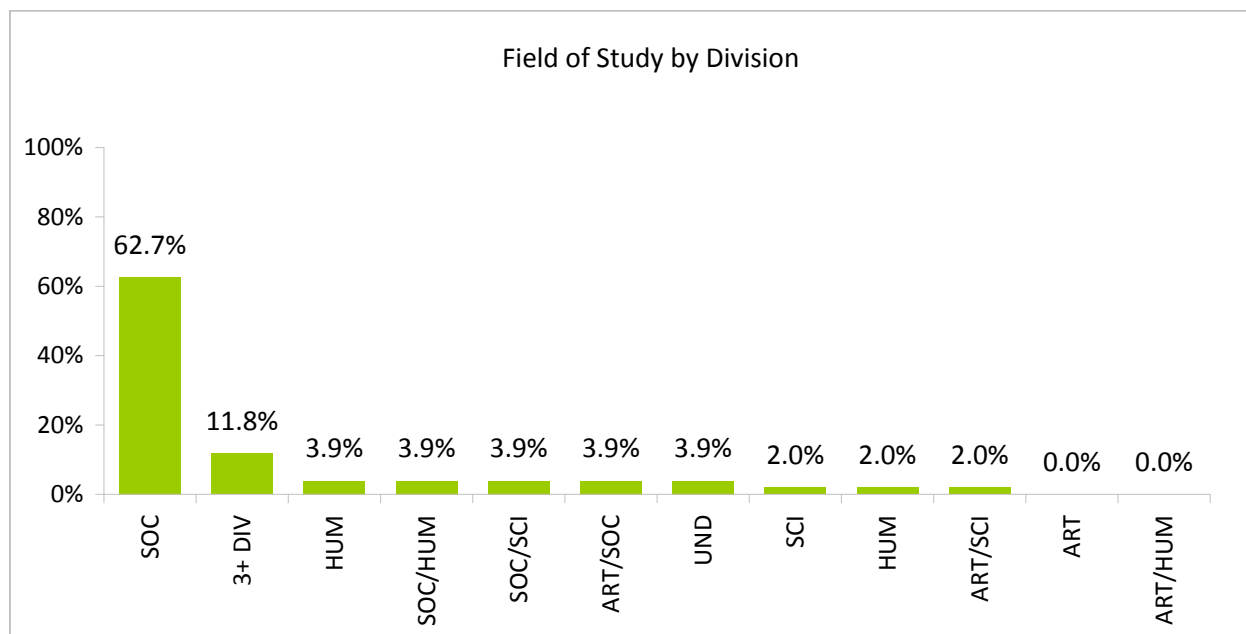
Primary Area of Study or Concentration - Divisional Analysis, Mutually Exclusive Categories

Students were asked to describe their primary field(s) of study or concentration at Evergreen. The open-ended responses to this question were grouped into the four academic divisions: art, social science, science, and humanities. The greatest proportion of Olympia campus respondents indicated Social Science only as their primary field of study (62.7%), followed by Three or More Divisions (3+ DIV) (11.8%), Humanities only, Social Science and Humanities, Social Science and Science, and Art and Social science (3.9%).
