























Satisfaction with the Learning Environment

Students were asked to indicate their level of satisfaction with different aspects of their learning environment at Evergreen. All items in this series had a median response of 3.00 ("Satisfied") or 4.00 ("Very Satisfied"). The items with the highest mean levels of satisfaction among Tacoma campus respondents were: interdisciplinary approach in academic work, level of respect you feel from faculty, team teaching by faculty, and the overall quality of instruction. Items with the lowest levels of satisfaction were: your ability to keep up the reading workload, the amount of time you are able to devote to your academic work, group projects and peer collaborations, and availability of information on the college website.
