


How far do you typically commute to your campus? (First-time, First-years)*

Students were asked a set of questions about typical commuting distances and ways of getting to campus. The average distance reported was 10.1 miles and the median distance was 5 miles. Respondents who lived on campus were not included in these calculations.

***How do you usually get to your campus?
(If you live on campus, how do you get to upper campus?)****

Students were asked to indicate modes of transportation that they typically used to commute to their campus.

Of the First-time, First-year respondents who lived off campus, 37.5% indicated that they drove alone, 31.3% carpoolled, 31.3% took the bus, 25% walked, 12.5% biked, 6.3% used both a bike and a bus. There were no First-time, First-year respondents who lived off campus who took a motorcycle or scooter to school.

Of the First-time, First-year respondents who lived on campus, 95.7% walked to upper campus, 6.5% rode their bike, 4.3% drove, and 2.2% used a motorcycle or scooter. There were no First-time, First-year respondents who lived on campus that carpoolled or took the bus.

How many miles is your typical commute?

Students were asked how many miles their commute was. First-time, First year respondents' answers are reported here, along with responses from the previous two Student Experience Surveys. In 2013 84% of respondents commuted from within 1 mile of campus, up from 75% of students in 2011. Respondents reported a commute of 1-5 miles 6% of the time, similar to the past two surveys. There was a decline of 9 percentage points for those who commuted 5-10 miles; from 10% in 2011 to 1% in 2013. These calculations include all First-time, First-year respondents - including those who lived on campus.
