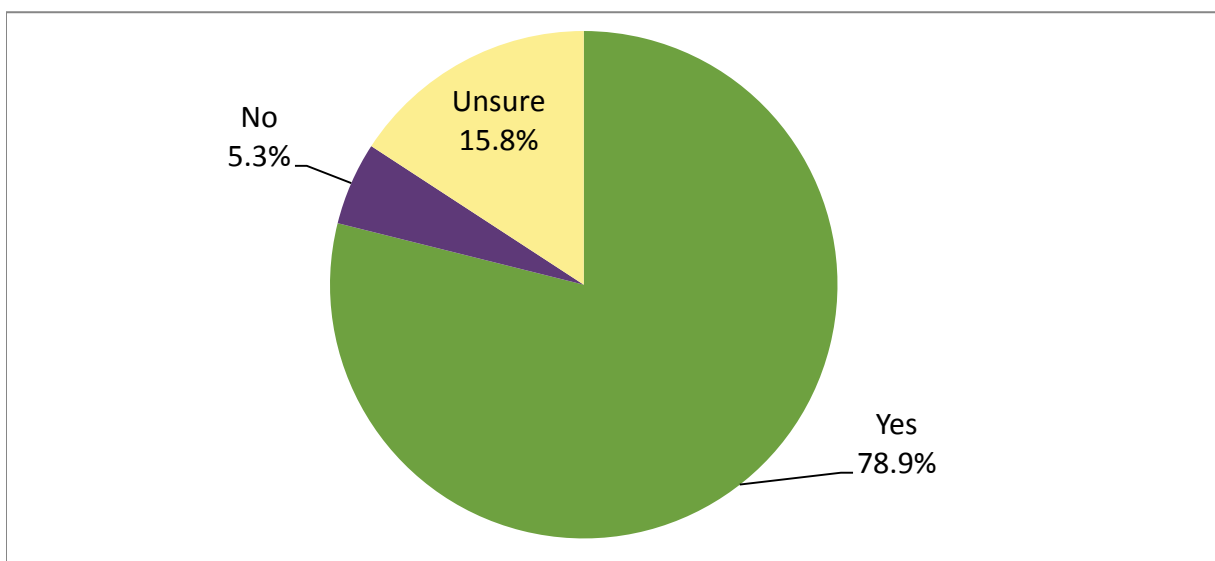


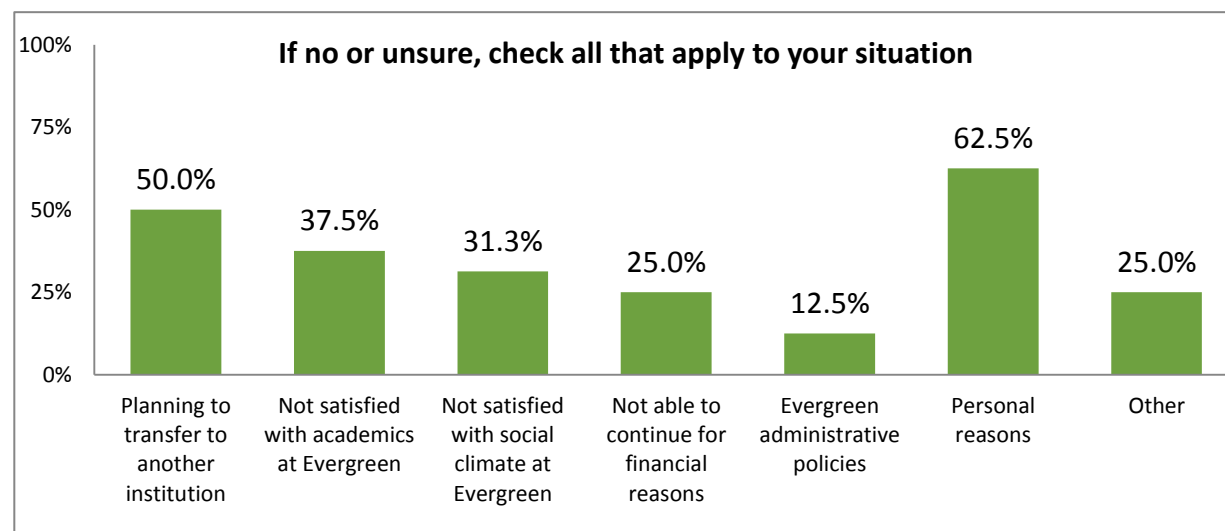
Do you plan to earn your Bachelor's Degree from Evergreen?

Students were asked if they intended to earn their Bachelor's Degree from Evergreen. Most First-time, First-year respondents indicated that they plan on getting their Bachelor's from Evergreen (78.9%). Just over 5% stated that they do not plan to earn their Bachelor's from Evergreen, while 15.8% were unsure. Of those who were unsure, 62.5% responded it was because of personal reasons, 50% were planning to transfer to another institution, 37.5% were not satisfied with academics at Evergreen, 31.3% were not satisfied with the social climate at Evergreen, 25% were planning to continue for financial reasons, 12.5% checked "Evergreen administrative policies," and 25.0% checked "Other."
