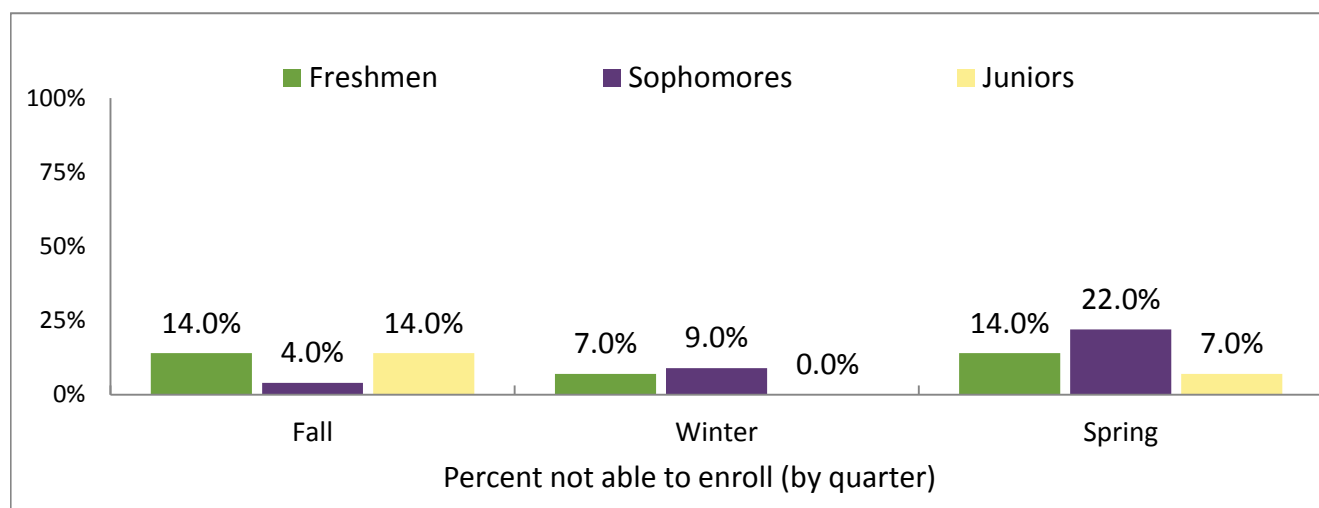


Were you able to enroll in your first choice of academic offerings?

Students were asked to indicate whether they were able to enroll in their first choice of academic offerings. The percent of First-time, First-year respondents who indicated that they could not enroll in their first choice of academic offerings ranged from a low of 0% for Juniors in winter to a high of 22% for Sophomores in spring.
