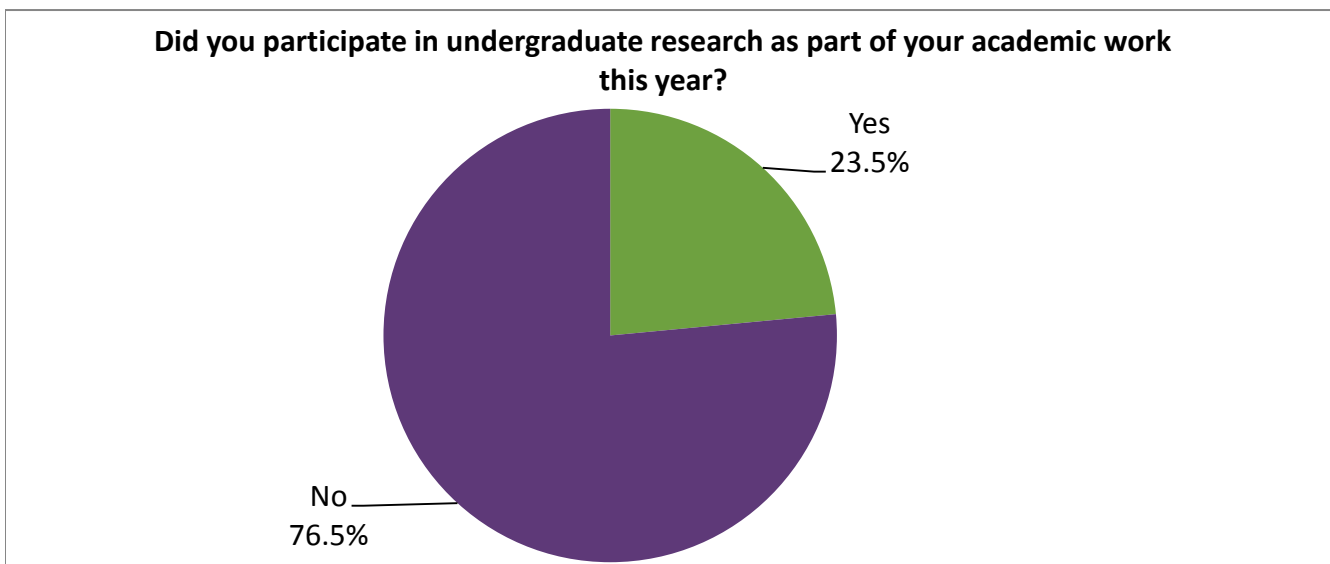


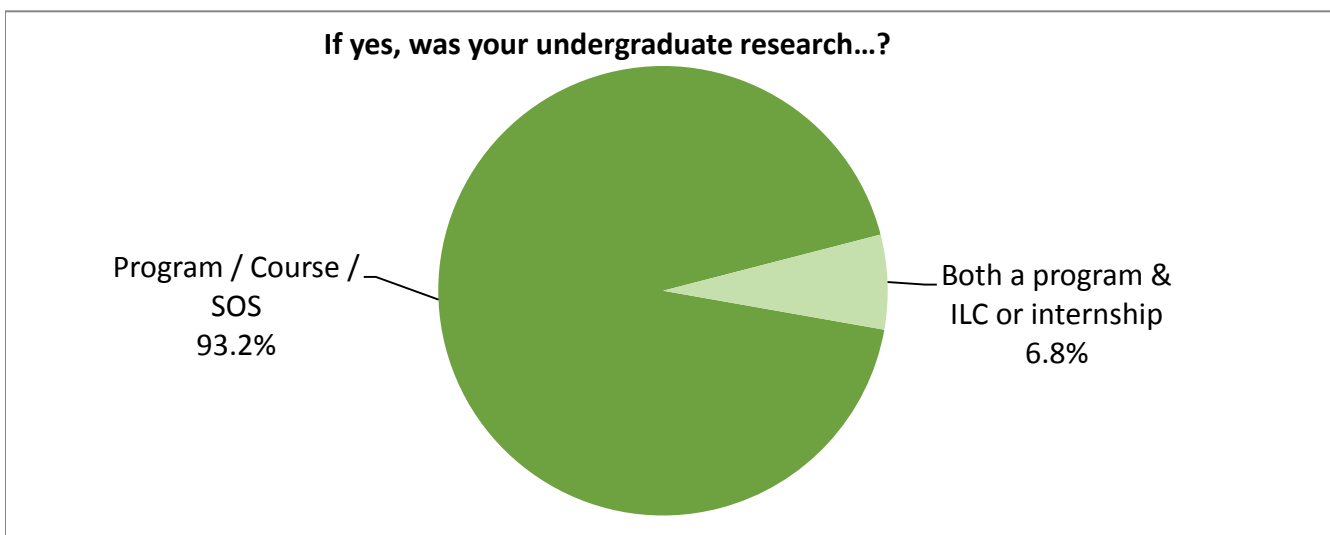
Did you participate in undergraduate research as part of your academic work this year?

Students were asked whether they participated in research as part of their academic work this year and whether it was part of a program/course/SOS or ILC. Most First-time, First-year respondents indicated that they had not participated in academic research (77%). Of the respondents who participated in undergraduate research, all of them participated during a program, course, or SOS. One student also participated in undergraduate research in an ILC or internship.
