






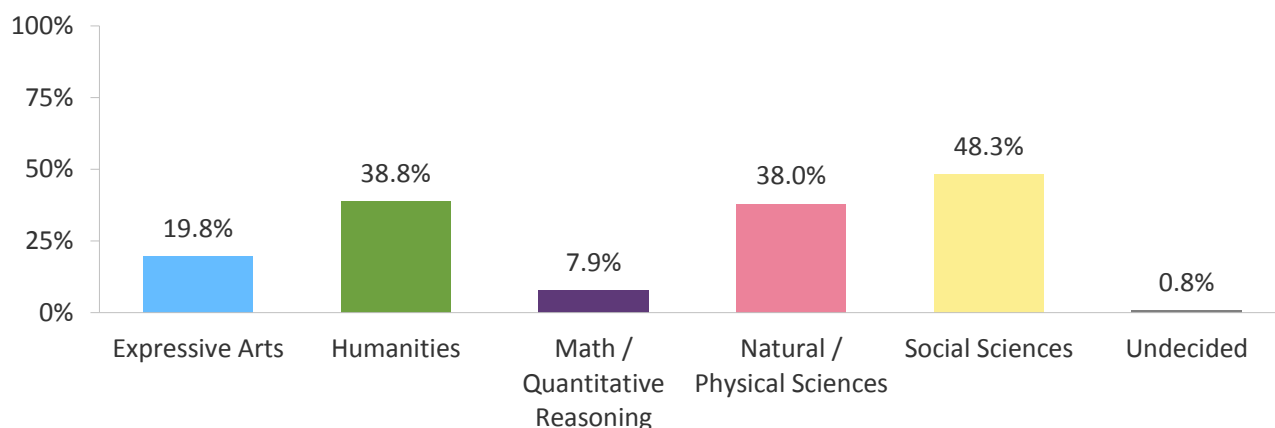


Describe your primary field(s) of study or concentration at Evergreen?

Students were asked to describe their primary field or fields of study at Evergreen. Nearly half of respondents indicated they were studying Social Sciences (48.3%), 38.8% were studying Humanities, 38.0% were studying Natural/Physical Sciences, 19.8% Expressive Arts, 7.9% Math/Quantitative Reasoning, and 0.8% were undecided. Students were allowed to choose more than one field, so the categories will not sum to 100%

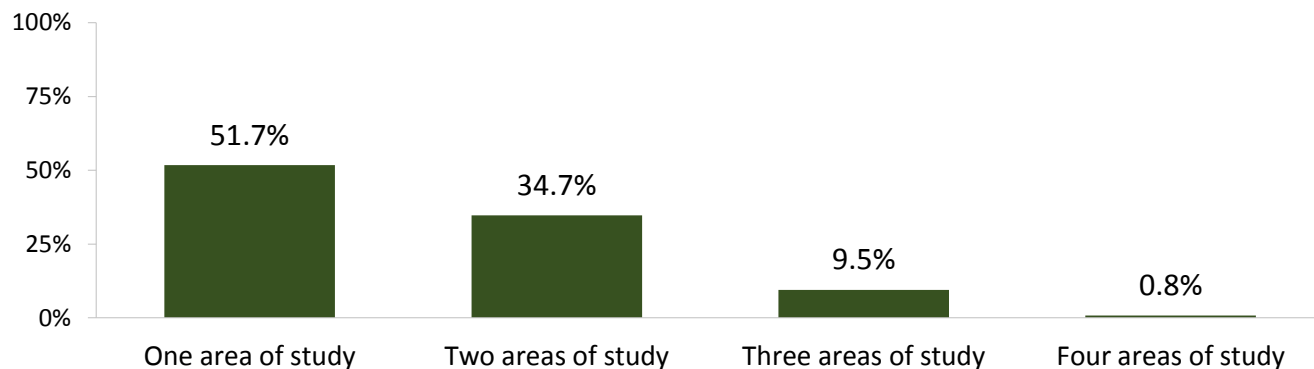

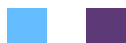
