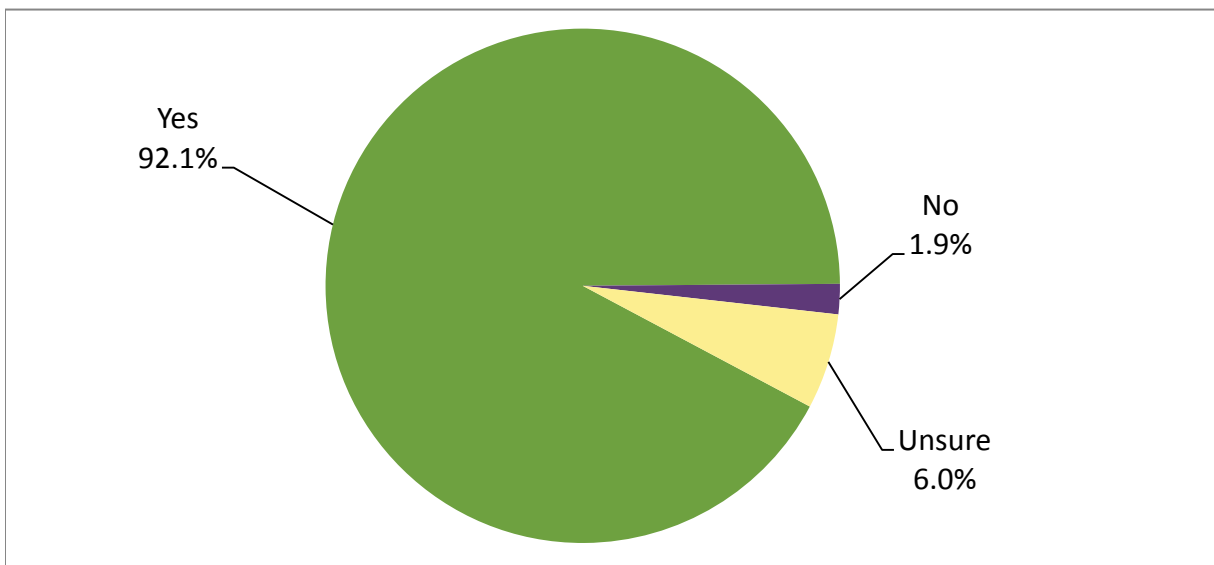


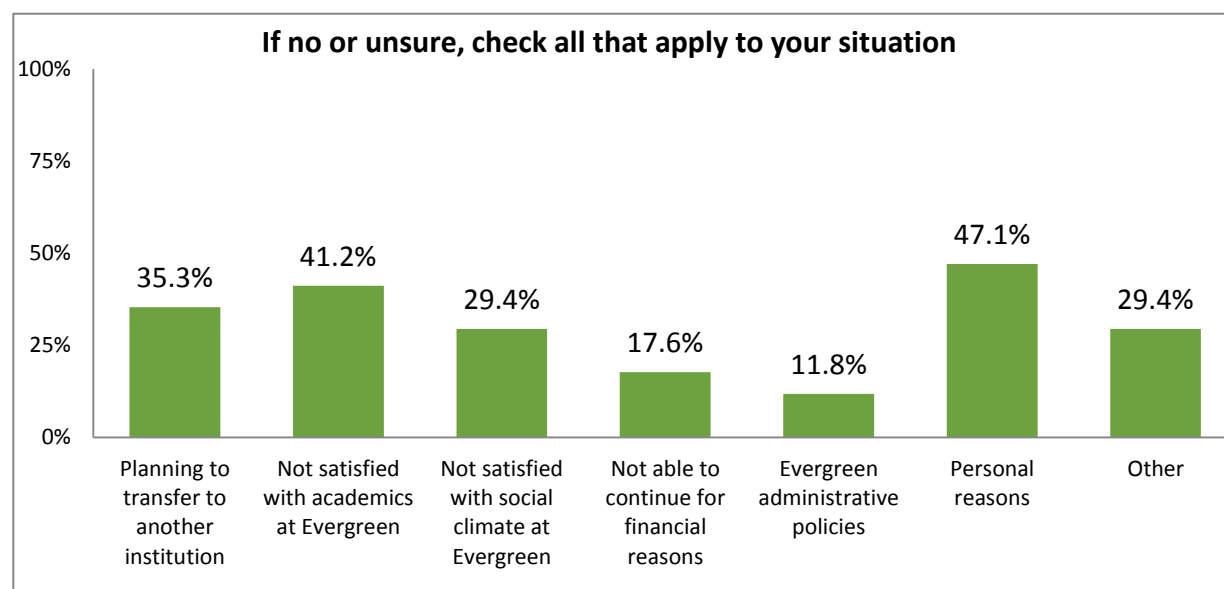
***Do you plan to earn your Bachelor's Degree from Evergreen?***

Students were asked if they intended to earn their Bachelor's Degree from Evergreen. Most Olympia Campus respondents indicated that they would be getting their Bachelor's from Evergreen (92.1%). Almost 2% stated that they do not plan to earn their Bachelor's from Evergreen, while 6% were unsure. Of those who were unsure, 47.1% said it was for personal reasons, 41.2% said they were not satisfied with academics at Evergreen, and 35.3% were planning to transfer to another institution.
