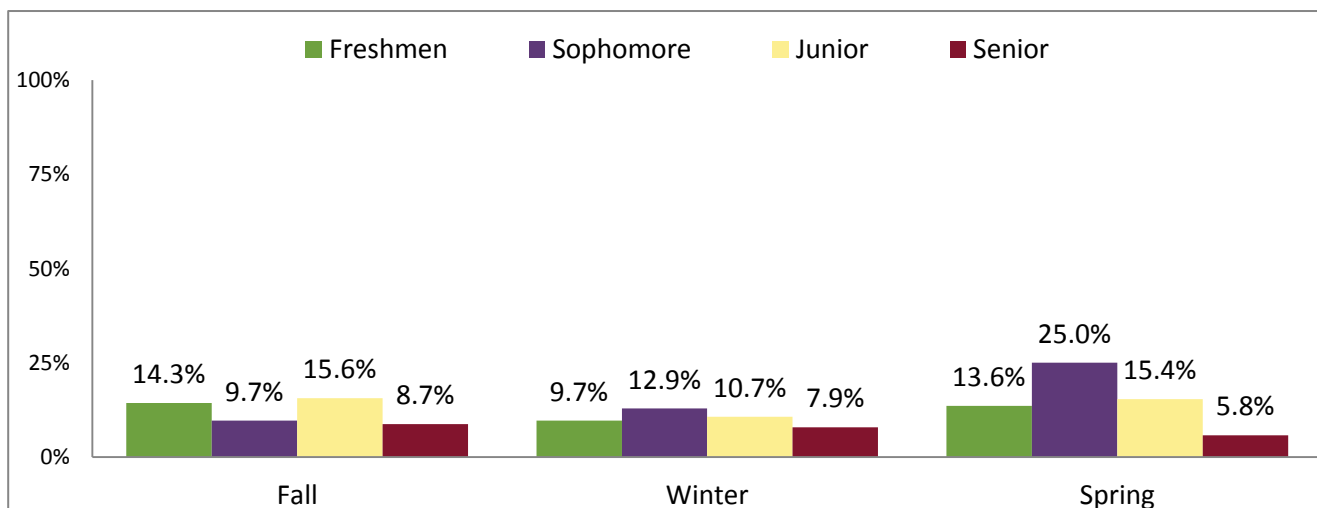


Were you able to enroll in your first choice of academic offerings?

The percentage of Olympia Campus respondents who indicated that they could not enroll in their first choice of academic offerings ranged from a low of 5.8% in spring for seniors to a high of 25% in spring for sophomores.
