


Did you participate in undergraduate research as part of your academic work this year?

Students were asked whether they participated in research as part of their academic work this year and whether it was part of a program/course/SOS or ILC. One-third of Olympia Campus respondents indicated that they had participated in academic research. Of these, 58% participated during a program, course, or SOS. Just under 32% participated during an Independent Learning Contract (ILC) or an Internship, and 3% participated in both **and** ILC/Internship and a Program.


Did you participate in undergraduate research as part of your academic work this year?
