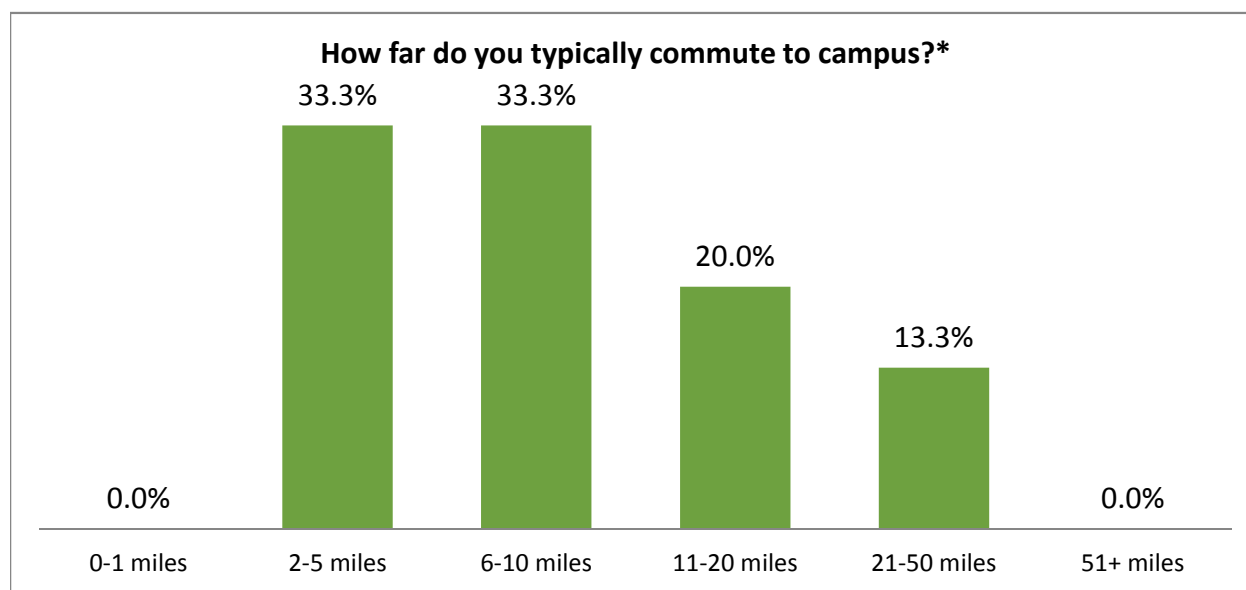


How far do you typically commute to your campus? (First-time, First-years)*

Students were asked a set of questions about typical commuting distances and ways of getting to campus. The average distance reported was 11.6 miles and the median distance was 8 miles. Respondents who lived on campus were not included in these calculations.

How do you usually get to your campus?**(If you live on campus, how do you get to upper campus?)***

Students were asked to indicate modes of transportation that they typically used to commute to their campus.

Of the First-time, First-year respondents who lived off campus, 60% took the bus, 46.7% drove alone, 46.7% carpooled, 13.3% biked, and 6.7% walked. There were no First-time, First-year respondents who lived off campus who took a motorcycle/scooter to school or who took a combination of bike/bus to school.

Of the First-time, First-year respondents who lived on campus, 93.3% walked to upper campus, 8.9% carpooled, 4.4% rode their bike, 4.4% responded other (longboards), and 2.2% drove alone or with children. There were no First-time, First-year respondents who lived on campus who used a combination of bike and bus or rode a motorcycle.

How many miles is your typical commute?

Students were asked how many miles their commute was. First-time, First year respondents' answers are reported here, along with responses from the previous two Student Experience Surveys. In 2015 79% of respondents commuted from within 1 mile of campus, down from 84% of respondents in 2013. Respondents reported a commute of 1-5 miles 7% of the time, similar to the past two surveys. There was an increase of 6 percentage points for those who commuted 5-10 miles; from 1% in 2013 to 7% in 2015. These calculations include all First-time, First-year respondents - including those who lived on campus.
