

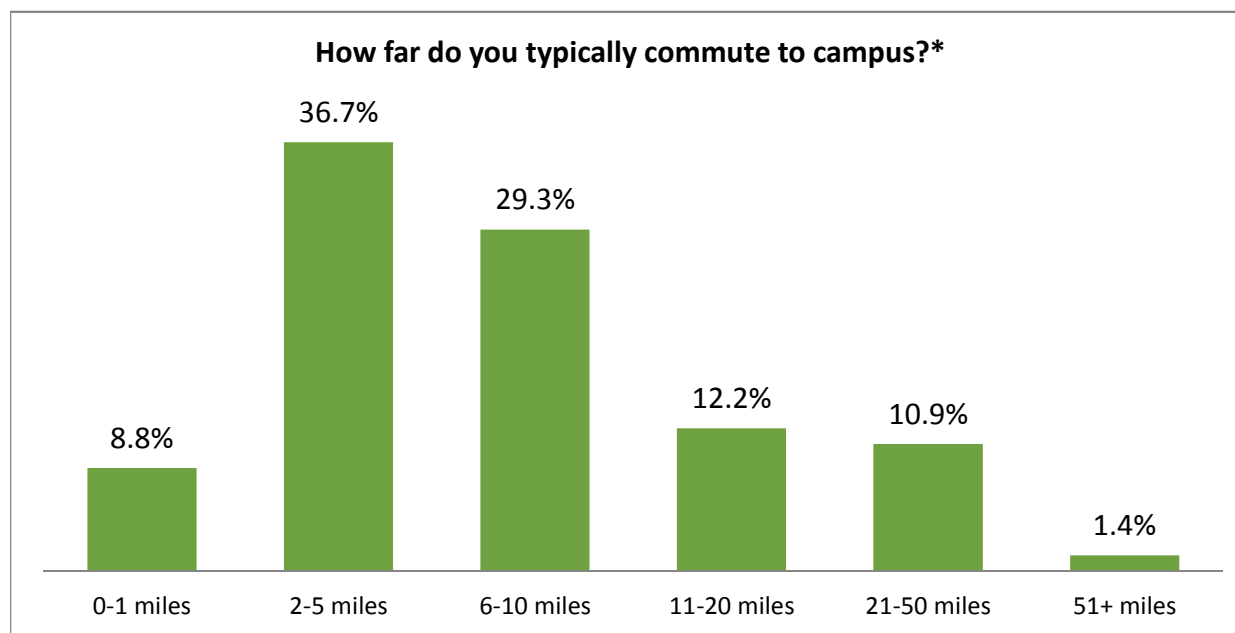
***How far do you typically commute to your campus? (Olympia Campus)\****

Students were asked a set of questions about typical commuting distances and ways of getting to campus. The average distance reported was 9.7 miles and the median distance was 6 miles.

Respondents who lived on campus were not included in these calculations.

36.7% of Olympia Campus respondents commute 2-5 miles (one-way) to campus, 29.3% 6-10 miles, 12.2% 11-20 miles, 10.9% 21-50 miles, 8.8% live within 1 miles, and 1.4% commute 51 miles or more to campus.



*\*Only the answers of respondents who indicated they lived off-campus were included in these calculations*

***How many miles is your typical commute?***

Students were asked how many miles their commute was. Olympia Campus respondents' answers are reported here, along with responses from the previous two Student Experience Surveys. In 2015 28% of students commuted from within 1 mile of campus, up 3 percentage points from 25% in 2013. 29% of respondents reported a commute of 1-5 miles, down 31% from the last survey. There was an increase of 3 percentage points for those who commuted 5-10 miles; from 20% in 2013 to 23% in 2015. These calculations are comprised of all Olympia Campus respondents - including those who lived on campus.

***How do you usually get to your campus?***

Students were asked to indicate modes of transportation that they typically used to commute to their campus.

Of the Olympia Campus respondents who lived off campus, 58.2% indicated that they drove alone, 37.0% took the bus, 17.8% carpooled, 8.9% biked, 8.2% walked, 6.8% used both a bike and a bus, and 1.4% used a motorcycle, moped, or scooter. There was one person who answered 'other,' and he or she said they rode a motorized bicycle to campus.

Of the Olympia Campus respondents who lived on campus, 96.9% walked to upper campus, 9.4% rode their bike, and 3.1% each took the bus, drove, or used a motorcycle or scooter. There were two people who answered 'other,' and they both said they rode a longboard to campus.
