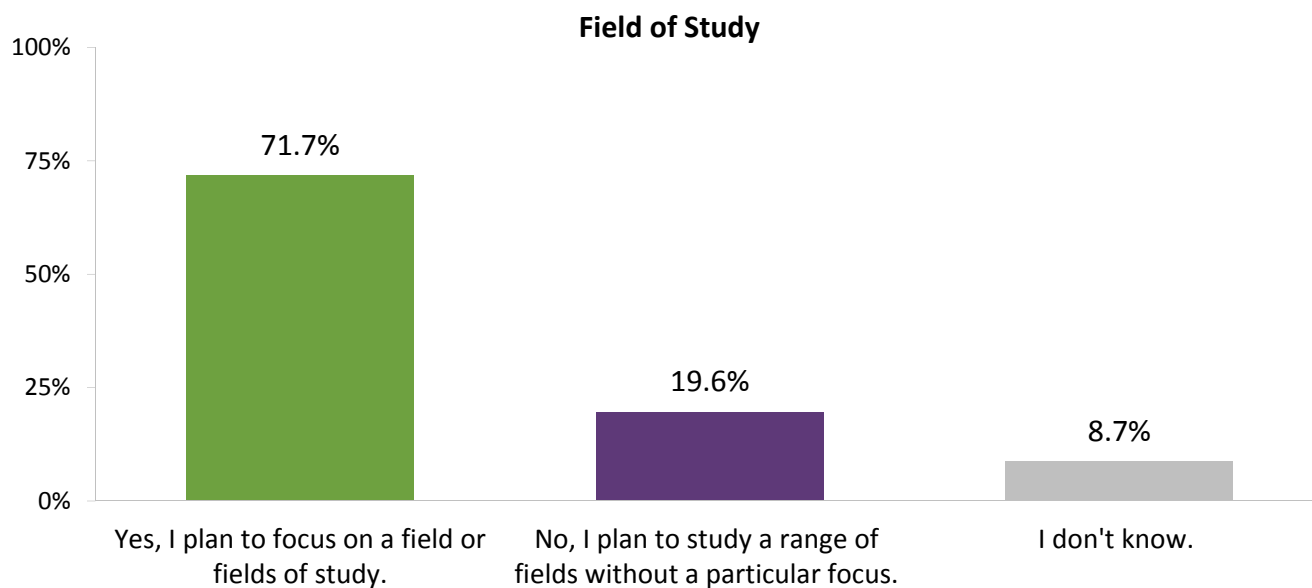


Do you plan to focus on a particular field or fields of study at Evergreen?

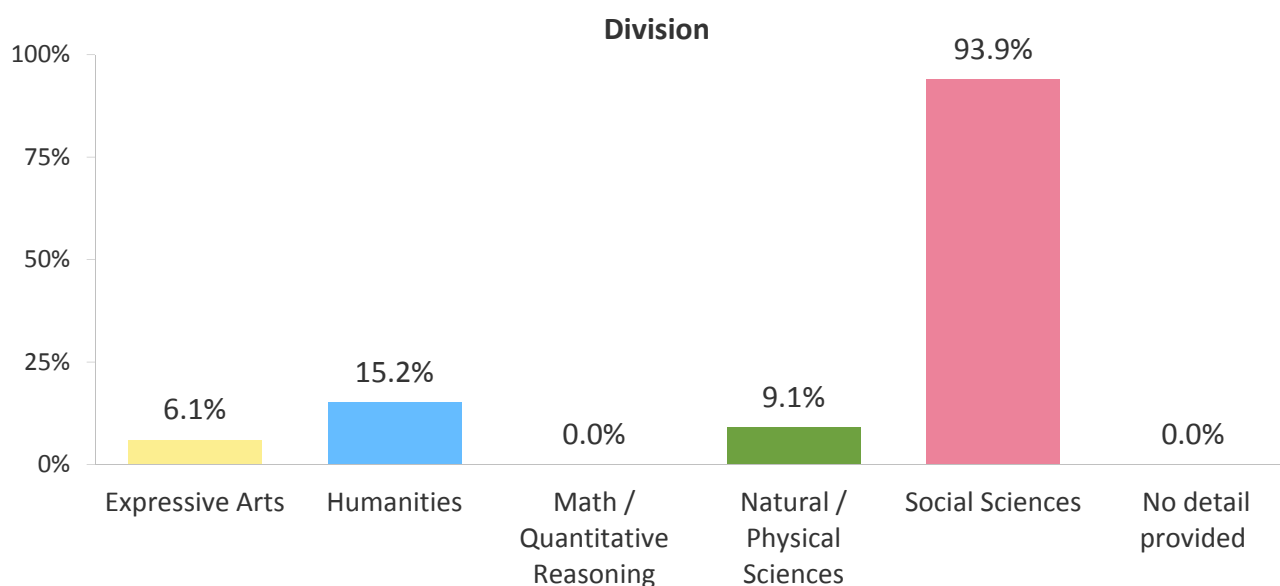


Describe your primary field(s) of study or concentration at Evergreen

Respondents who indicated they planned to focus on a field or fields of study were asked to provide detail of their field of study. These areas of study were categorized into five divisional areas. 93.9% of Tacoma Campus respondents are studying Social Sciences, followed by 15.2% focusing on Humanities, 9.1% on Natural/Physical Sciences, and 6.1% on Expressive Arts. No Tacoma Students are focusing on Math/Quantitative Reasoning.

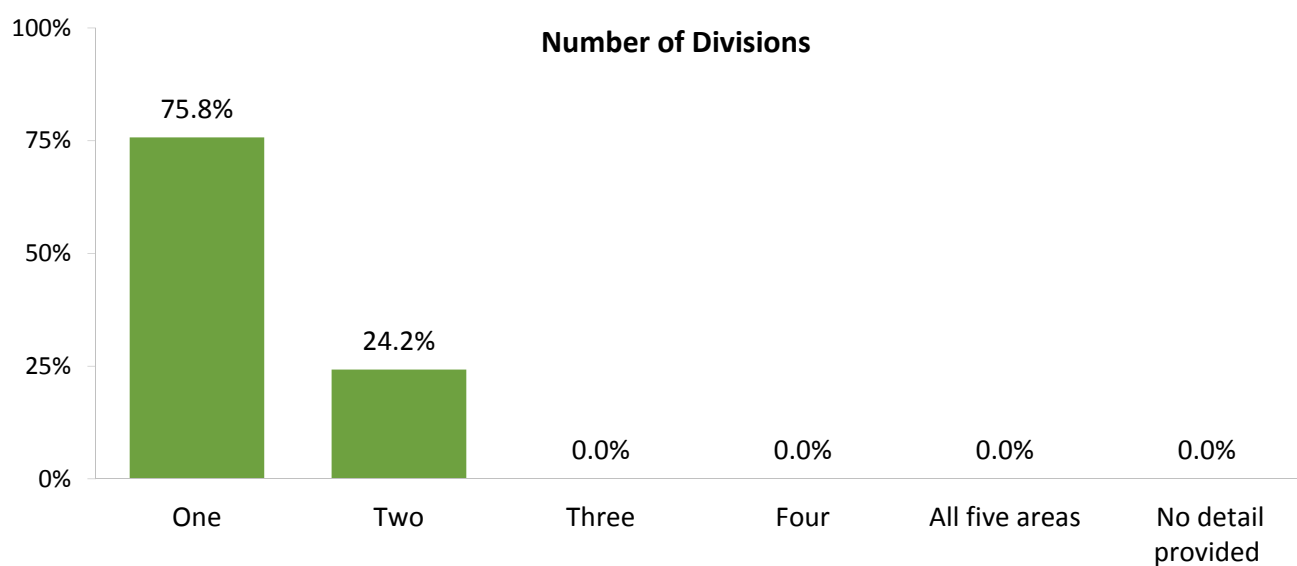
