Contemplative Studies	Designing an individual study project was a component of Contemplative Studies. Several students developed community service projects as part of their individual projects (e.g., Iggyhop, GRUB, hospice, elder care, Waldorf aftercare).
City Life	Students completed city field studies in specific communities.
America Abroad	Quarter-long internships (or volunteer service) with NGOs abroad or community-based institutions in the U.S., including research projects, for many students; also quarter-long intensive independent study of communities for others.
