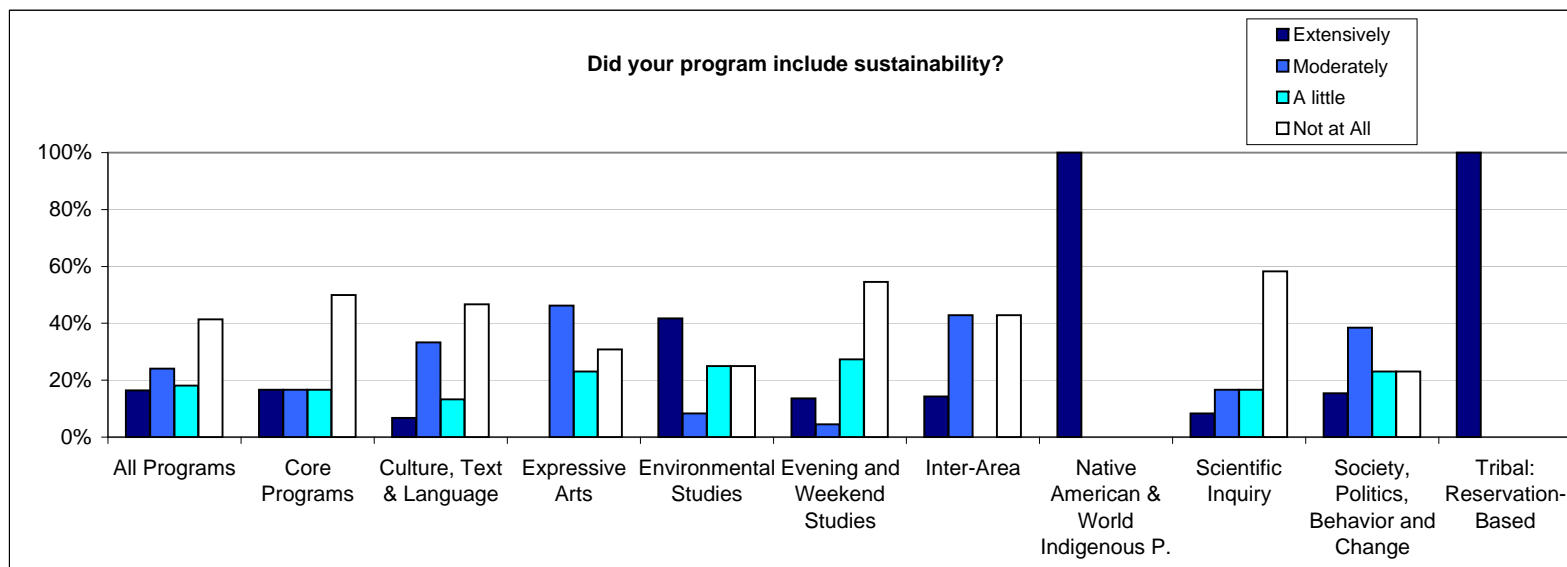


## End-of-Program Review 2007-08
