SPBC programs with community-based project(s) and/or service learning

	Description of activities
Decolonizing the Mind	Students sought advice and help from the community based learning office. From there they were able to identify and locate in many cases residents from different countries whom the students later interviewed.
Gateways: Popular Education and Political Economy	We had college classes and cultural diversity with workshops with students who are incarcerated. Evergreen students also worked extensively with the center for community based learning and action.
Race in the United States: Historical and Contemporary Perspectives"	Collaborative research (students teams of 3) into 8 western Washington communities to determine degree of history of racial exclusion and recommendations for remedies
Behavioral Medicine	Students formed groups and wrote grant proposals for community projects reflecting the course material. They had a second group project where they held four showings on campus of the film Unnatural Causes: Are Social Inequalities Making Us Sick? and moderated discussions.
Multicultural Counseling	Two-quarter internship 4-6 credits/quarter.
What Are Families For?	One day a week at Garfield School or equivalent hours at a low-income after school center.
SOS: Social Services and Social Justice	Independent projects (mostly internships) based on students' interests. internship organizations were in the areas of civil law, education, queer rights, domestic violence, and child welfare. one student did an independent participant observation project on a permaculture homestead to study sustainability and waste management.
