Reservation Based Community Determined Program - Nisqually	Cindy Marchand-Cecil	The most compelling project we have done was developing podcasts for the Nisqually Reach work. Sadly, there was insufficient technical assistance available for off-site programs to allow us to develop them at the time or into the future. It is our present understanding that there is only support for this kind of effort for on-site, daytime, full-time programs, but not for off-site, evening full-time programs. The work of American Indian people is very important and having our students be able to develop podcasts to record work/events/issues in their communities should be a priority at our school.
