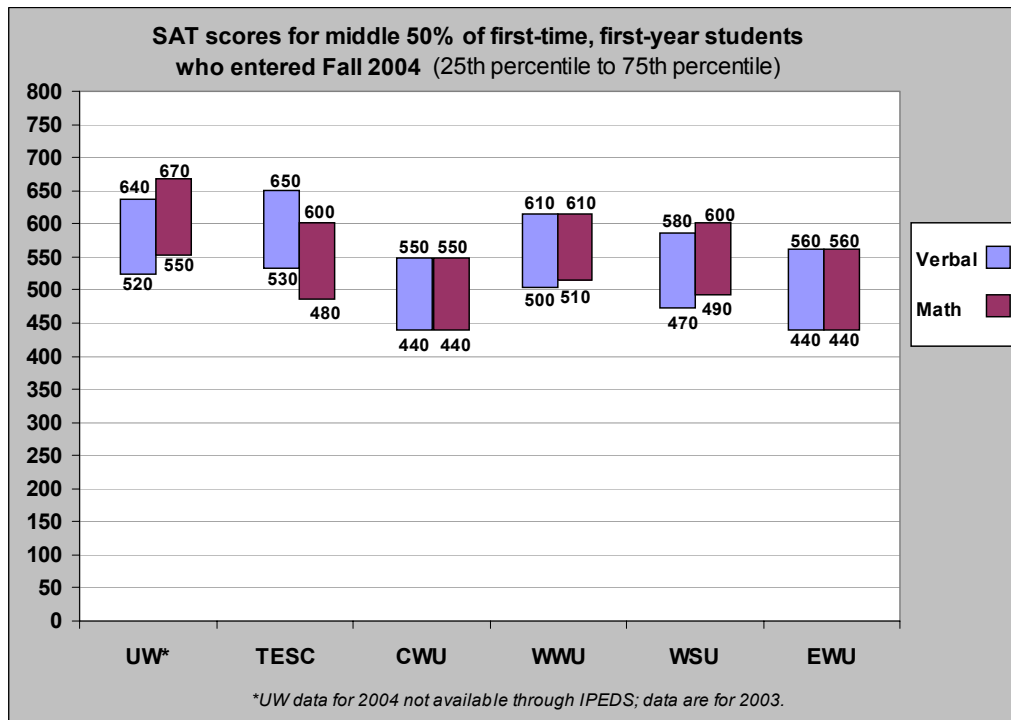


## SAT scores for entering freshmen at public baccalaureate institutions in Washington

Of the six public baccalaureate colleges in Washington, Evergreen's new freshmen class in Fall 2004 had the highest middle 50% range for the verbal SAT. (This means that half of the entering class scored between 530 and 650 on the verbal SAT). 50% of Evergreen's new freshmen scored between 480 and 600 on the math SAT. This middle range is higher than CWU and EWU's new freshmen, and is quite similar to the range for WSU. UW and WWU's freshmen had a higher middle range for the math SAT than Evergreen's freshmen.

The data for Fall 2004 are very similar to a comparison of mean SAT verbal and math scores conducted for the entering freshmen of Fall 2000. In Fall 2000, Evergreen's new freshmen had the highest mean verbal SAT score and the third highest SAT math score of the six public baccalaureates.
