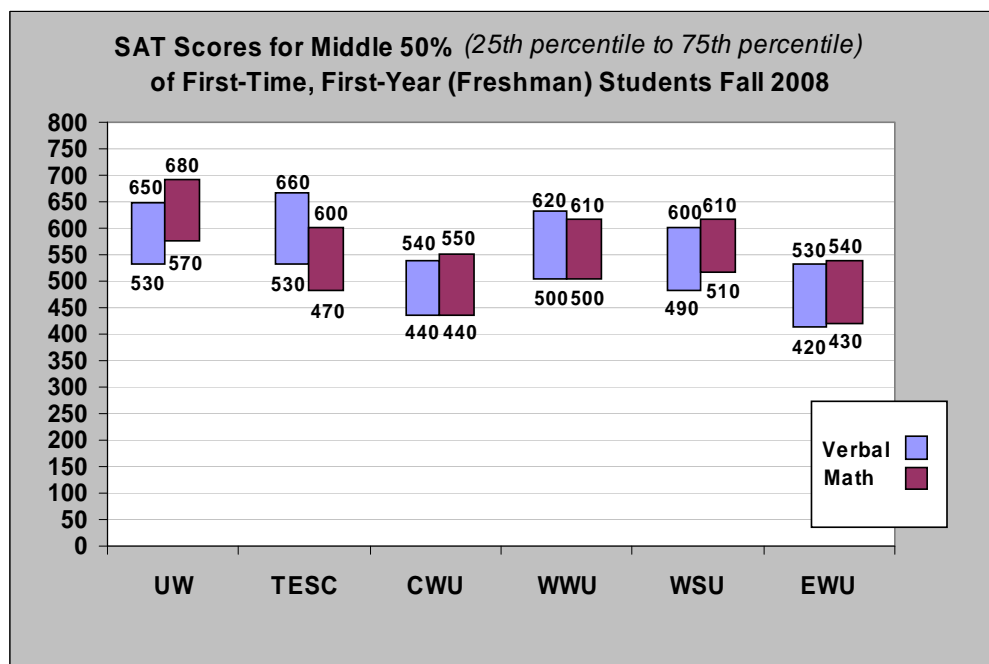


SAT Scores and GPAs for Entering Freshmen at Public Baccalaureate Institutions in Washington

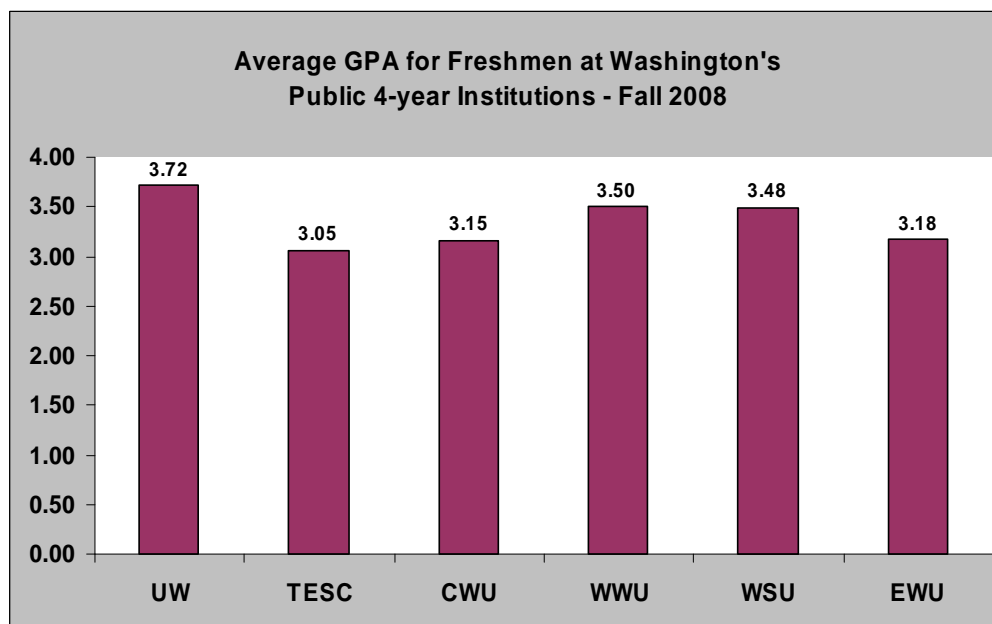
Of the freshmen entering Washington's six public baccalaureate institutions in fall 2008, Evergreen's freshmen scored highest on the verbal SAT. The middle 50% of our entering class scored between 530 and 660, outperforming the UW whose freshmen slightly outscored ours in 2007. Evergreen freshmen consistently score at or near the top of this peer group on the verbal SAT. On the math SAT, Evergreen's middle 50% scored between 470 and 600 – higher than CWU and EWU's new freshmen; lower than freshmen at UW, WWU and WSU. This ranking is also fairly consistent over time, reflecting the reality that as a liberal arts college Evergreen may be more of a magnet for students whose verbal skills are strong relative to their quantitative skills.
