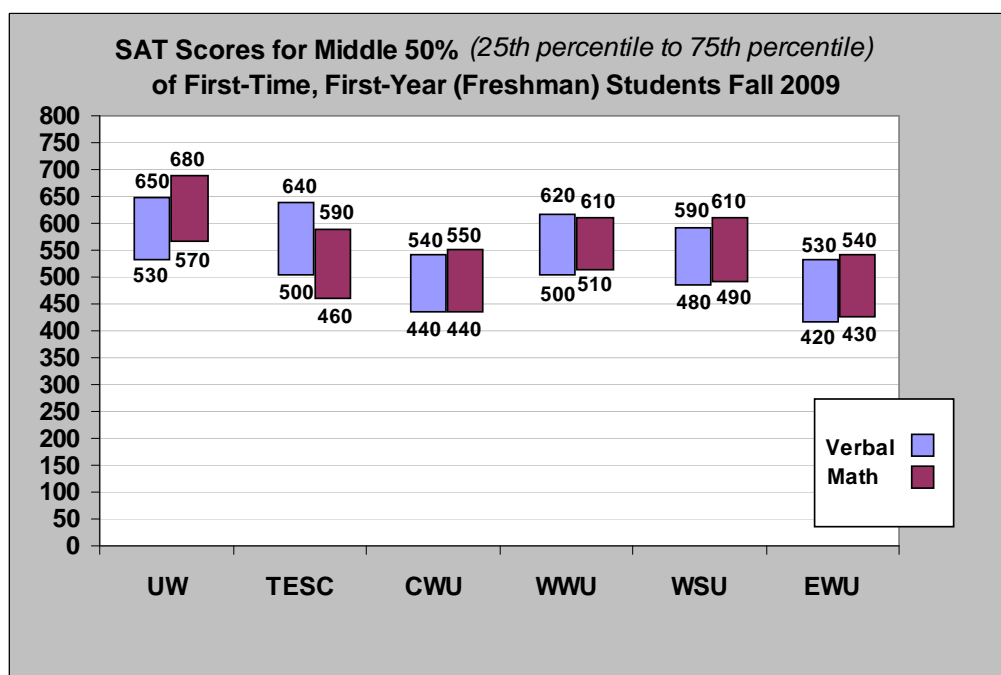


SAT Scores and GPAs for Entering Freshmen at Public Baccalaureate Institutions in Washington

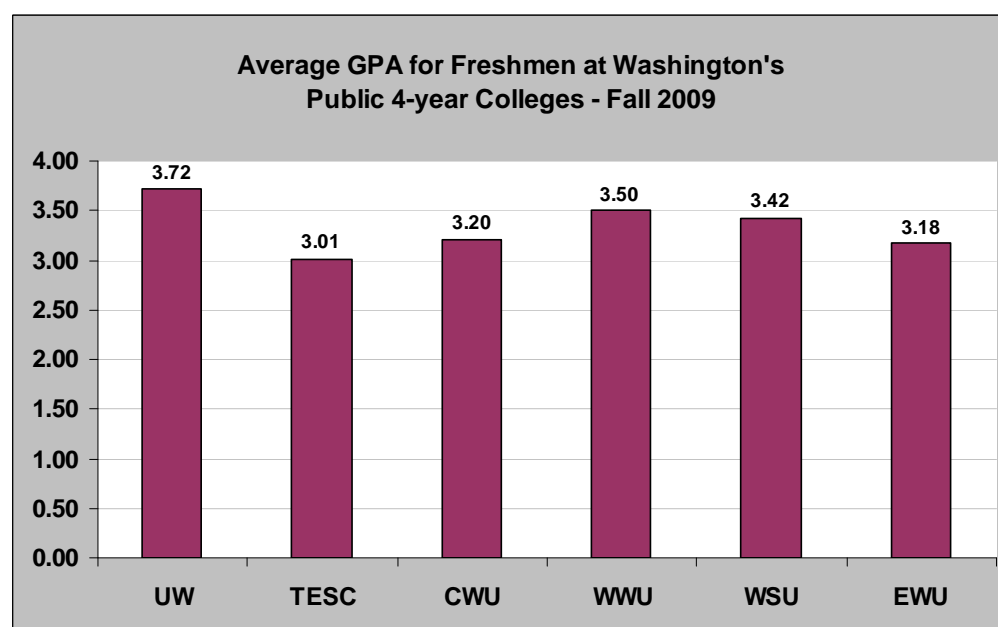
Of the freshmen entering Washington's six public baccalaureate institutions in fall 2009, Evergreen's freshmen scored second only to the UW on the verbal SAT. The middle 50% of our entering class scored between 500 and 640; UW freshmen scored slightly higher with verbal scores between 530 and 650. Evergreen freshmen consistently score at or near the top of this peer group on the verbal SAT. On the math SAT, Evergreen's middle 50% scored between 460 and 590 – higher than CWU and EWU's new freshmen; lower than freshmen at UW, WWU and WSU. This ranking is also fairly consistent over time, reflecting the reality that as a liberal arts college Evergreen may be more of a magnet for students whose verbal skills are strong relative to their quantitative skills.
