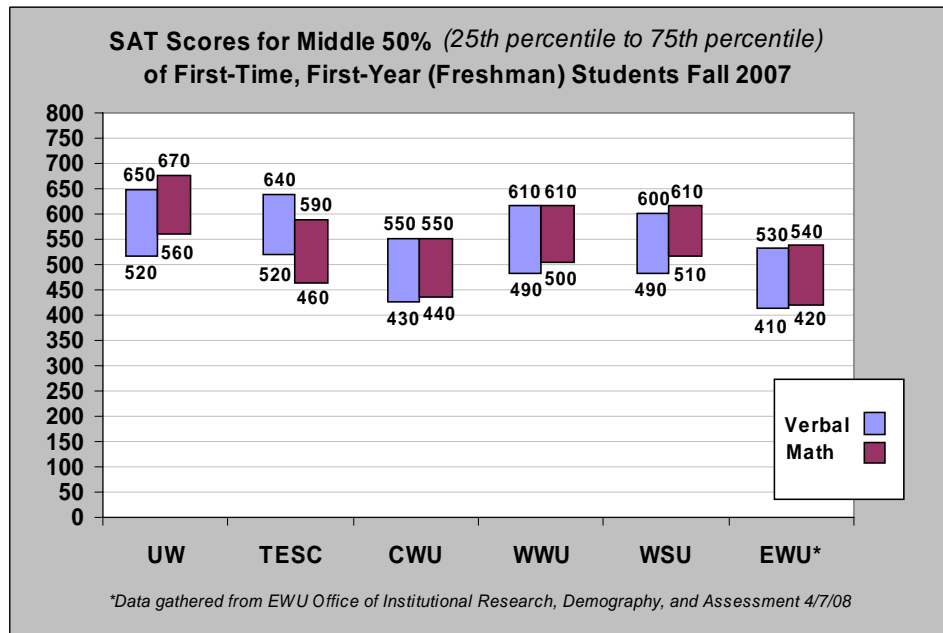


SAT Scores for Entering Freshmen at Public Baccalaureate Institutions in Washington

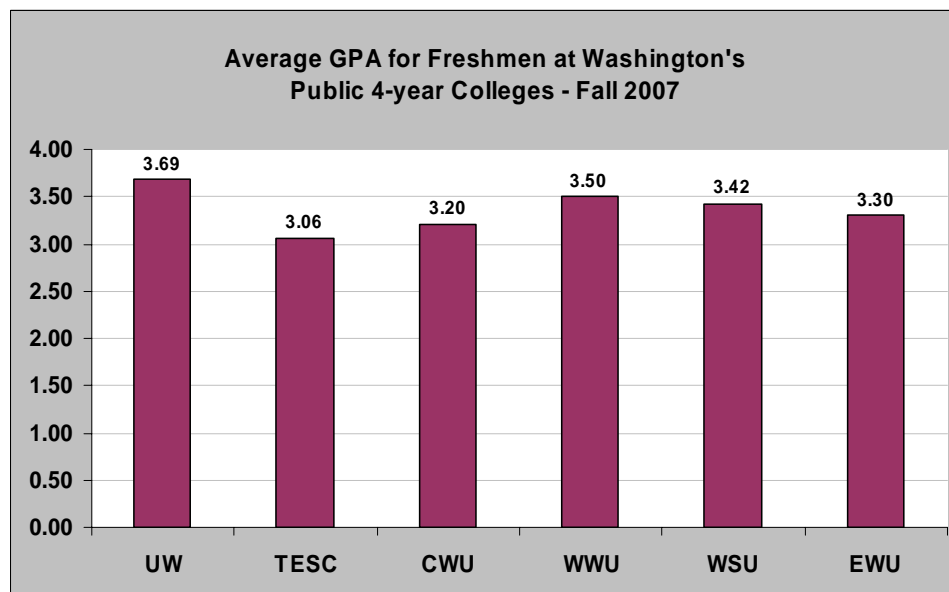
Of the six public baccalaureate colleges in Washington, Evergreen's Fall 2007 freshmen scored second only to UW freshmen on the verbal SAT. Half of our entering class scored between 520 and 640, compared to the middle 50% of UW freshmen who scored between 520 and 650. Evergreen freshmen consistently score at or near the top of this peer group on the verbal SAT. On the math SAT, Evergreen's middle 50% scored between 460 and 590 – higher than CWU and EWU's new freshmen; lower than freshmen at UW, WWU and WSU. This ranking is also fairly consistent over time, reflecting the reality that as a small liberal arts college Evergreen may be more of a magnet for students whose verbal skills are strong relative to their quantitative skills.
