Academic Statement Initiative

Reason for the Initiative

The results of the discussion about the survey focused on assessing the impact of an academic initiative on Student Affairs services and the overall Orientation program administered by Student Affairs

Plan Dates and Assessment of Initiative

Review of activities during Orientation will occur during fall quarter to develop an initial scope of the impact to be reported and used in order to plan for 2013 when the academic statement becomes a requirement

Transfer Students Experiences Initiative

Survey transfer students who live on campus and off campus regarding their experience to determine if services needs are different for this cohort of students

Description of the initiative

Survey transfer students regarding their experience based on living on campus or off campus

Reason for the Initiative

Survey data indicate that there may be a difference in the experience of transfer students who live on campus and those who live off campus

Fall, 2011

Position Responsible

SASS Dean and Director of Academic Advising (and Academics when and as appropriate)

Planned Dates of Assessment of Initiatives

Develop a brief Fall 2012 survey to distribute to transfer students, similar to “How’s it going cards,” with specific questions related to living on or off campus
