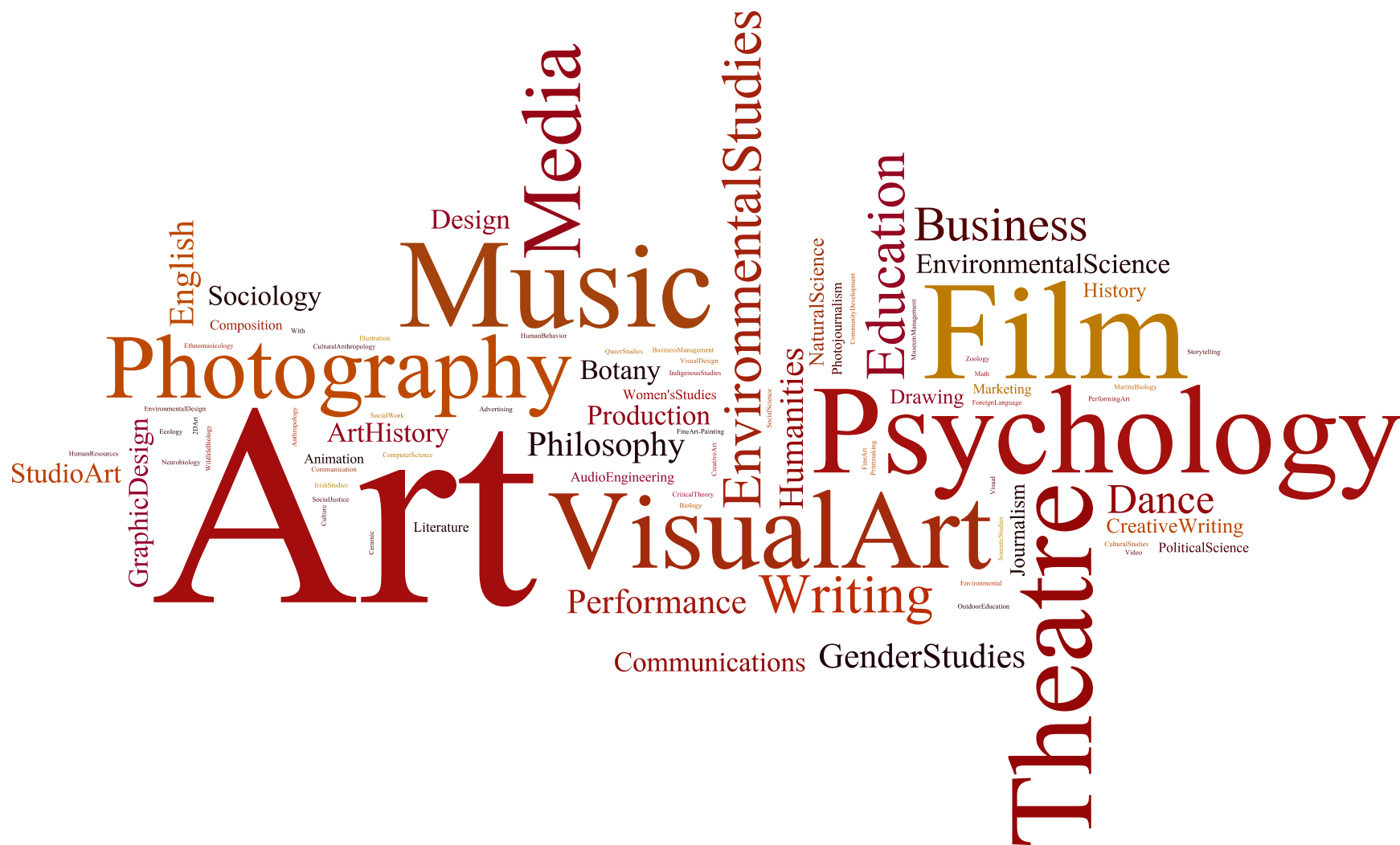


Please describe your primary field(s) of study or concentration at Evergreen.

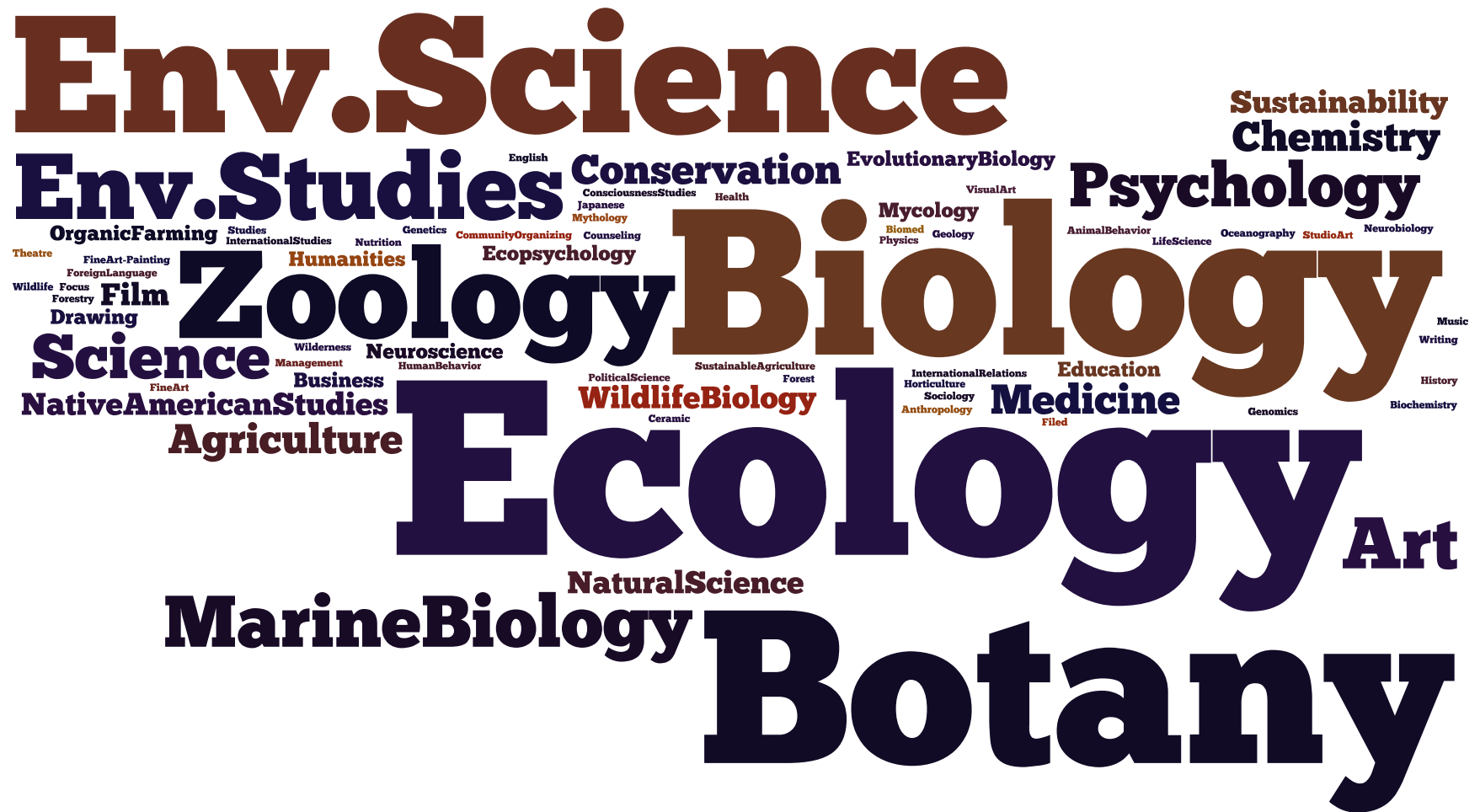

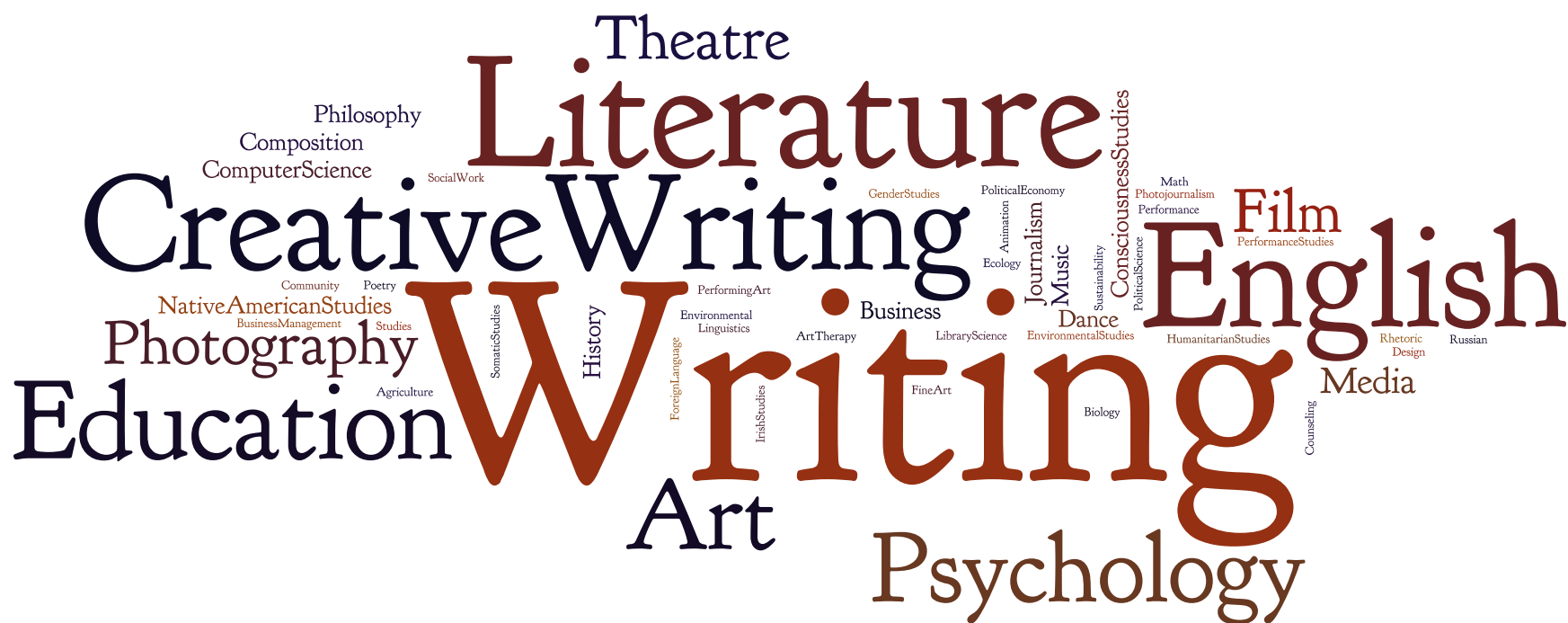
