## Attend the Academic Fair!

### Wednesday, November 30th, 4:00 - 6:00 pm, CRC

The [Academic Fair](#) for Winter Quarter will be held Wednesday, November 30th in the CRC. This quarterly event gives you an opportunity to meet and talk with faculty teaching winter programs and classes, get questions answered, or obtain any faculty signatures that might be needed.

Take some time before the Fair to [review the catalog](#) and identify some programs or courses that interest you. Be sure to check the [catalog](#) regularly - a couple of new programs were recently added to the winter curriculum.

## Registration for Winter Quarter Starts Dec. 5th

The [Registration](#) office has sent an e-mail to [your Evergreen e-mail account](#) directing you to check your time ticket. If you haven't checked your account to get your timeticket info, do that right away! Registration for seniors starts Monday, December 5, juniors on Tuesday, December 6, sophomores on Wednesday, December 7, freshmen on Thursday, December 8.

Popular programs and classes can and do fill in a matter of minutes, so it's crucial that you be at a computer, ready to register at 8:00 am on your registration day.

If you're planning to join a continuing program that started in fall, be sure to contact the faculty - either at the [Academic Fair](#) or by [email](#) - to make sure you know what to do over break to have a strong start in the program.

### Registration tips from Academic and Career Advising:

- Review the [How to Register](#) information on the [Registration and Records](#) website.
- Check your time ticket in [my.evergreen.edu](#) to verify your class level and what day you register.
- Make sure that you're using the correct CRN number for your class level.

- Check to ensure you don't have any holds on your account. You should do this at least 2 days ahead of your registration date. If you do, they'll show up in a yellow "To Do" box on the right side of your main [my.evergreen.edu](http://my.evergreen.edu) screen.
- Write down the CRN numbers for several options. If you don't get into your first choice, [waitlist yourself](#) and immediately register for your second choice.

This year five Evergreen students received [Benjamin A. Gilman Scholarship](#) awards totalling \$16,500 to support their learning abroad for winter and spring quarters 2017. Congratulations to the current round of students on the hard work they put into their applications, and many thanks to the multiple offices and individuals at Evergreen who supported these students in the process! These scholarships will support student engagement in the following programs:

Since the Gilman Scholarship's beginning, 191 Evergreen students have received scholarships to support their study abroad.
