**Announcements**

**Student Organization Event**

SDS is planning an event on April 12. At the workshop, participants will learn about the history of electronic civil disobedience and learn how to plan and participate in them in an anonymous manner. In essence, the workshop will teach how to overload a server so it doesn't function. SDS will be bringing their own server to show how to execute the overload and it will not affect any other computers on or off campus. The group also plans a second workshop: How to Anonymously Browse the Web and Communicate Online Using Tor on April 21. There is no violation on of policy to talk and learn about these topics, provided there is no incitement to commit illegal acts.
