**Enrollment Update**

Steve Hunter provided a preliminary report on fall 10th day enrollment. Headcount stands at 4,759, a slight decrease from the previous year. The FTE enrollment is 4,811, as slight increase. Non-resident enrollment is at 1,166, a decrease of 29 students from the previous year, but above the target set for quarter.

**Curriculum Overview**

Paul Przybylowicz presented an overview of the curriculum, focusing on the distribution of students, faculty and seats in the Olympia daytime curriculum. Paul described strategies that the Deans use in an effort to align space in the curriculum with student demand.

**Goal Setting**

John Carmichael presented the flip chart notes from the summer retreats. The group discussed work that might be done to promote civil discourse and to respond to the "new normal." John will draft a set of goals that we might refer back to later in the year.
