Lavender Graduation is an annual ceremony that celebrates the academic achievements of graduating LGBTQQIAA+ students. This is the 3rd Annual Lavender Graduation Ceremony at Evergreen. This is an annual graduation tradition that was first held in 1995 at University of Michigan by Dr. Ronnie Sanlo, who was inspired by cultural graduation ceremonies that were held in honor of Black, Latinx, Indigenous, and Asian students, as well as her own experience of being barred from attending her children's graduation ceremonies due to her sexual orientation. 25 years later, it is has become an annual tradition for colleges and universities nationwide.
