### If you have already submitted 2023 income information for your 2025-2026 file, contact our office.

You may also fill out Form 4506-T and send that to the IRS to get a copy by mail. If you are not able to obtain one, we can accept a signed copy of your 1040 form. If you amended your taxes after you filed, we will also need a signed copy of your 1040X.
