### Designated Transfer Degree

- Associate of Arts (DTA)
- Associate of Science, Track I
- Associate of Science, Track II

This designated degree will transfer as a block of 90-credits to Evergreen. Applicants who have earned, or who will earn, this degree prior to entering Evergreen are awarded the highest admission preference.

### Designated Technical Transfer Degrees

- Early Childhood Education (AAS-T only)

These designated technical transfer degrees may transfer as a block of 90-credits to Evergreen if the following conditions are met:

- You have earned a designated technical transfer degree listed above
- You have successfully completed college-level English composition (ENG 101) or equivalent with a 2.0 grade or better
- You have a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or better

Applicants who have earned, or who will earn, one of these degrees prior to entering Evergreen are awarded the highest admission preference.

- AAS - Database Management
- AAS - Early Childhood Education

- (AAS-T) – Computer Aided Drafting/Building Information Modeling
- (AAS –T) - Computer Information Technology: Computer Programing Emphasis

An acceptable Upside Down Degree *may* transfer to Evergreen as a block of 90-credits after you have completed 32 Evergreen credits in a program you select with the help of an Academic Advisor. You are eligible for the Upside Down Degree Program if you meet the following criteria:

- You have earned an approved technical degree listed above
- You have successfully completed college-level English composition (ENG 101) or equivalent with a 2.0 grade or better
- You have a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or better

You are eligible for the Conditional Guaranteed Admission for International Students if you meet the following criteria:

- You have earned an approved degree listed on page 1 of this document
- You have successfully completed English 101 and English 102 with a grade of “B” (3.0 grade) or higher in both courses
- You have a cumulative college-level GPA of 2.75 or better
- You demonstrate proof of financial ability
