

**CLUC Minutes**  
**01/28/13**

Meeting started at 3:10pm

Minutes from 11/19/12 were approved as presented.

- 1) Robyn passed out a hard copy of an email she sent out prior to the meeting, which included three wording options for signs that would be installed on various campus trail heads. L&I had been investigating a bike accident on the Organic Farm Trail and recommended placing signs on either end of the various trails on campus, which would warn people about the trails not being improved.  
After some discussion the committee chose the wording "Caution - Natural Surface Trail – hikers, bikers, wildlife".  
Paul will recommend this to John and once he approves this request we will install the signs in the next few months.
- 2) The teahouse program ordered a storage container for their building materials. The drop site for that container will be on Parking lot C for now; the Facilities Prius parking space to be precise. In the meantime the Prius will be parked on the gravel lot next to the Carving Studio. Michelle Pope will attend the CLUC meeting in February or March and inform the committee of further plans for that container.  
Paul gave a quick review of the Teahouse project and their current progress.
- 3) Nate inquired about College re-zoning updates and Rich explained that there are no major updates; the only update is that the College sent a letter and got the three local legislators to send letters to the County Commissioners to get the college's rezoning request on the planning docket for review sometime in the next year to year and a half. In regards to the boundary line adjustment we encountered a little problem but the College is working on correcting it.
- 4) RAD was requested to be at this meeting in regards to their smoking shelter and their desire to make the area larger. They would like to increase the size of the shelter and gravel the ground because it gets quite muddy in the winter. The shelter has been well received and RAD would like to accommodate more people. Andrew Beattie agreed to donate a set of pool bleachers for the site if the project was approved by the CLUC.

The meeting ended at 3:30pm.
