Minutes from 3/21/2016 were approved as presented.

Introductions

Smoking Shelter Close to the Childcare Center – Jeanne Rynne

In February 2016 a concerned parent and student approached the Health and Safety Committee, stating that smoking on campus, particularly at the new smoking shelter at the CUP, has a harmful effect on the children and staff in the Childcare center.

Based on the discussion with the mentioned parent, the Health and Safety Committee approached John Hurley in an email, to remove the smoking shelter.

In response to that email, John Hurley asked the CLUC to assess

- a) The extent to which smoke from the shelter located near the Cooling and Utilities plant (CUP) can reach the Child Care Center.
- b) The extent to which smoke from Parking Lot C and the Parking Lot for the CUP can reach the Child Care Center.
- c) The appropriate disposition for the smoking shelter if in fact smoke is reaching the Child Care Center from the shelter. (For example: should it be removed and placed in a different location? Should it be removed and not replaced? If removed and replaced, who should fund the project?)
- d) If additional signage is needed on the path in from Lot C. If smoke is in fact coming from Lot C, please advise Jeanne Rynne on where no smoking signs could be placed to rectify the situation.
- e) Develop a recommendation about enforcing the no smoking policy that has been put into effect for the campus core.

After discussion the CLUC came to the following conclusion:

1. More enforcement by Police Services and a better communication plan.
2. Remove/Abandon current smoking shelter.
3. Relocate the shelter close to an unofficial path on the CUP side, off of the paved path between the CRC and the CUP but the CLUC could not identify a satisfactory funding source for this relocation.
4. Fining people but that would require opening up a WAC.

Jeanne presented potential projects for the Capitol Budget Request 2017-19 and the group discussed them.
