Showers for Women (Susan Bustetter):

- There is a need to have showers available in other buildings than the CRC. The committee agrees that with the increase of alternative transportation methods more people will need to shower on campus. Paul suggests the need to alter our building guidelines, so that every building will have a men and women, or unisex shower. For the buildings that have already been renovated the Vice President of the department needs to fill out an SRI for next biennium. Paul will look at possibilities for showers to be installed in the Library.
- In the interim the Lab II shower can be made co-ed. It needs to have a lock installed and a co-ed sign on it. Paul will talk to Marty about adding those features. Check with CRC, Do you have to belong to it to use the showers, only?

John Hurley's Recommendation:

- Paul and Patti hope to have a schedule for the Space Efficiency Study by the December's 2008 Space meeting. Paul would like to have results in by December 2009 or January 2010.

All Other Items:

- What is the scheduled for people moving back to the Library? The surge schedule will be discussed at the Vice Presidents' meeting next week. After that Patti will let all departments know their move date.
- When is Longhouse going off-line? March 1, 2009.
- When is Conference Services moving out of the CAB? Patti says sometime during Winter 2009. The date has not been scheduled yet, possibly in mid-March. Greenery won't surge before June and possibly August. Sheryl prefers that the Greenery move in August so that summer conferences go more smoothly. She needs a space for a week during June 20-27, 2009.
