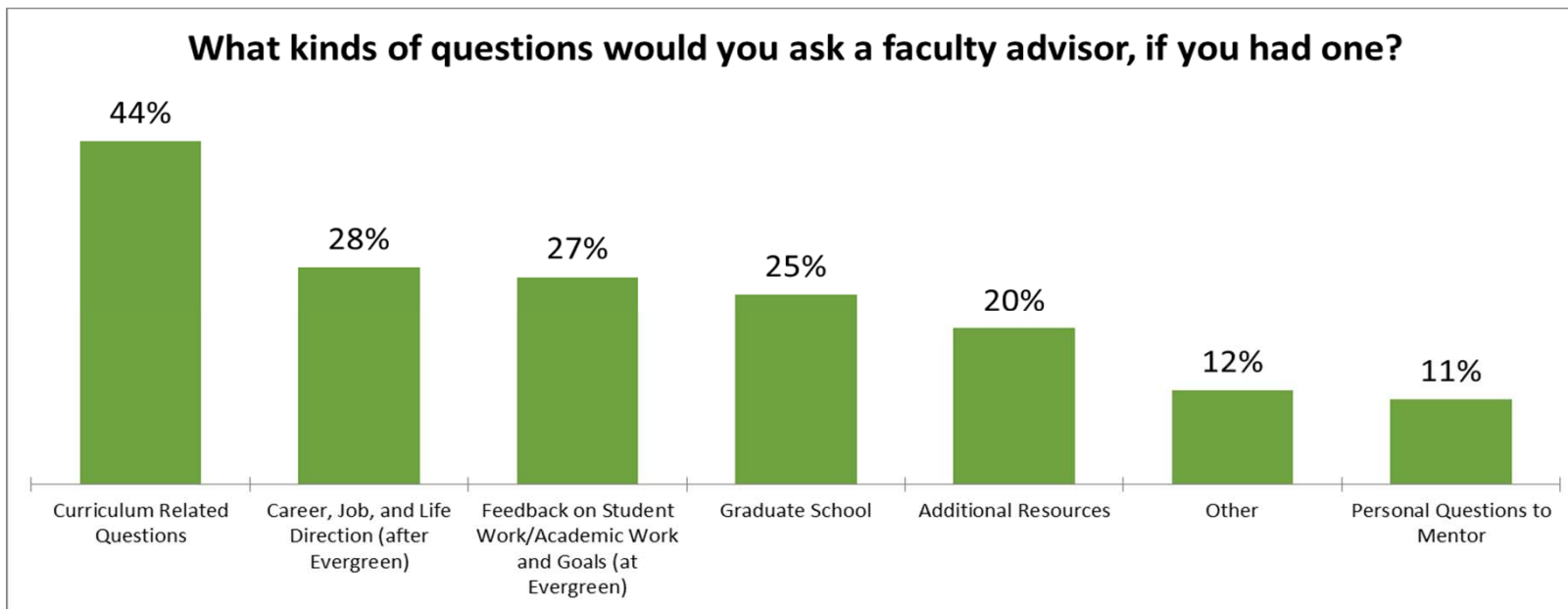


**The Evergreen State College  
Evergreen Student Experience Survey 2011**

**Total Respondents  
Faculty Advisor**

Students were asked the open-ended question "Imagine you had a single faculty advisor over the course of your Evergreen education; what kinds of questions would you ask that person?" Responses were categorized into groups. The distribution of comments is summarized below in descending order of frequency. The largest group of respondents would ask questions related to curriculum (44%), followed by career, job, and life direction (after Evergreen) (28%), feedback related to the student's academic goals at Evergreen (27%), graduate school (25%), additional resources (20%), other (12%), and personal questions of the mentor (11%).



Responses were also analyzed by class standing and results are shown in the charts below.

Every class-level of students was most likely to ask curriculum-related questions.

- Freshmen asked questions relating to Curriculum (39%), Career, Job and Life Direction after Evergreen (26%), Feedback on Student/ Academic Work & Goals at Evergreen (22%), and Graduate School (22%)
- Sophomores asked questions relating to Curriculum (46%), Career, Job and Life Direction after Evergreen (32%), Feedback on Student/ Academic Work & Goals at Evergreen (24%), and Graduate School (17%)
- Juniors asked questions relating to Curriculum (51%), Feedback on Student/Academic Work & Goals (at Evergreen) (32%), Career, Job and Life Direction after Evergreen (29%), and Graduate School (25%).
- Seniors asked questions relating to Curriculum (39%), Graduate School (29%), Career, Job, and Life Direction after Evergreen (27%), and Feedback on Student/Academic Work & Goals at Evergreen (26%).
