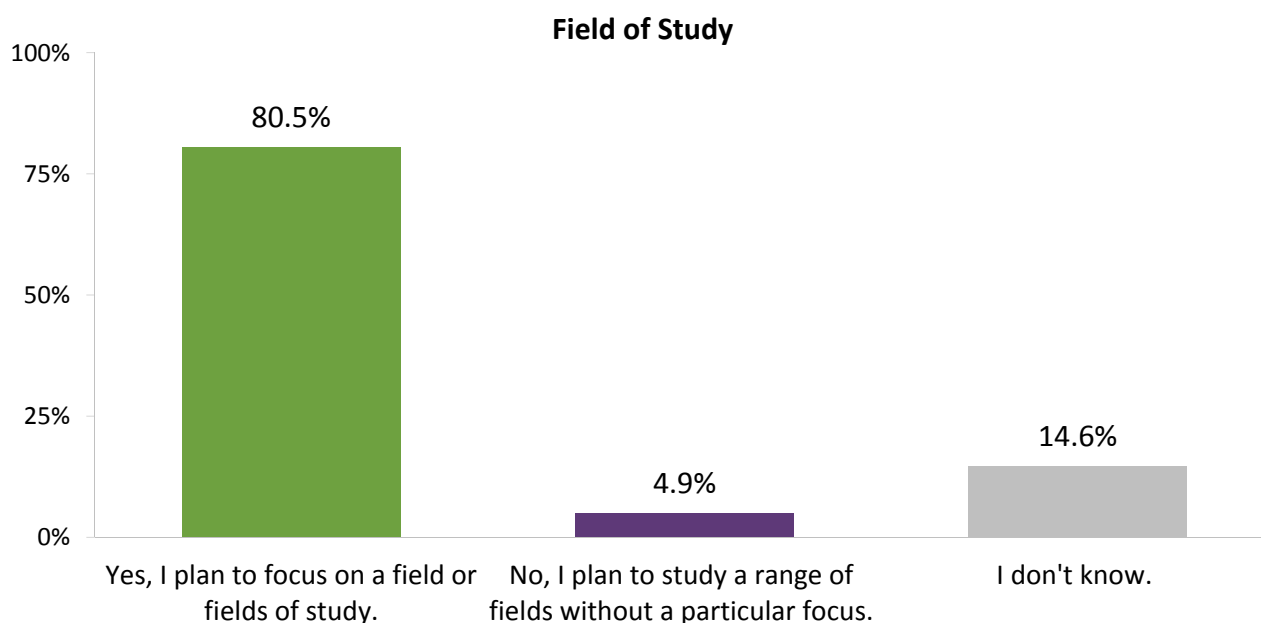


***Do you plan to focus on a particular field or fields of study at Evergreen?***







First-time, First-years students were asked if they planned to focus on a particular field of study - 80.5% plan to focus on a field or fields of study, 4.9% plan to study a range of fields, and 14.6% do not know.

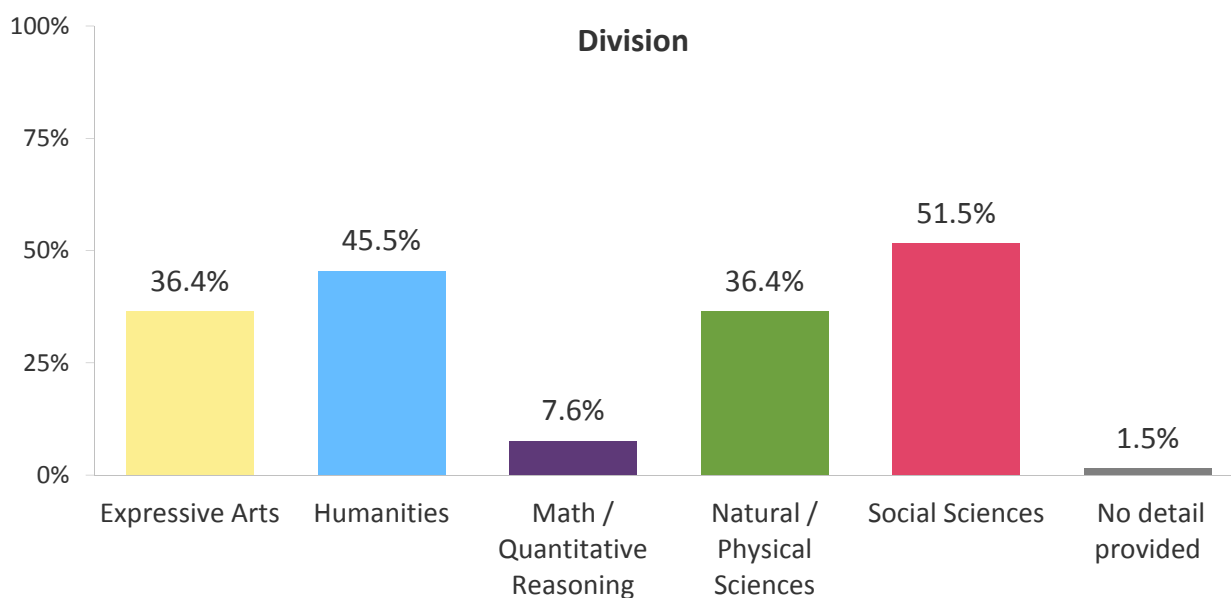


**Describe your primary field(s) of study or concentration at Evergreen**

Respondents who indicated they planned to focus on a field or fields of study were asked to provide detail of their area of study. These areas of study were categorized into five divisional areas. 51.5% of respondents are focusing on Social Sciences, 45.5% on Humanities, 36.4% were studying Natural/Physical Sciences, 36.4% Expressive Arts, and 7.6% Math/Quantitative Reasoning. One respondent did not provide additional detail about his/her focus of study. Students were allowed to choose more than one field, so the categories will not sum to 100%

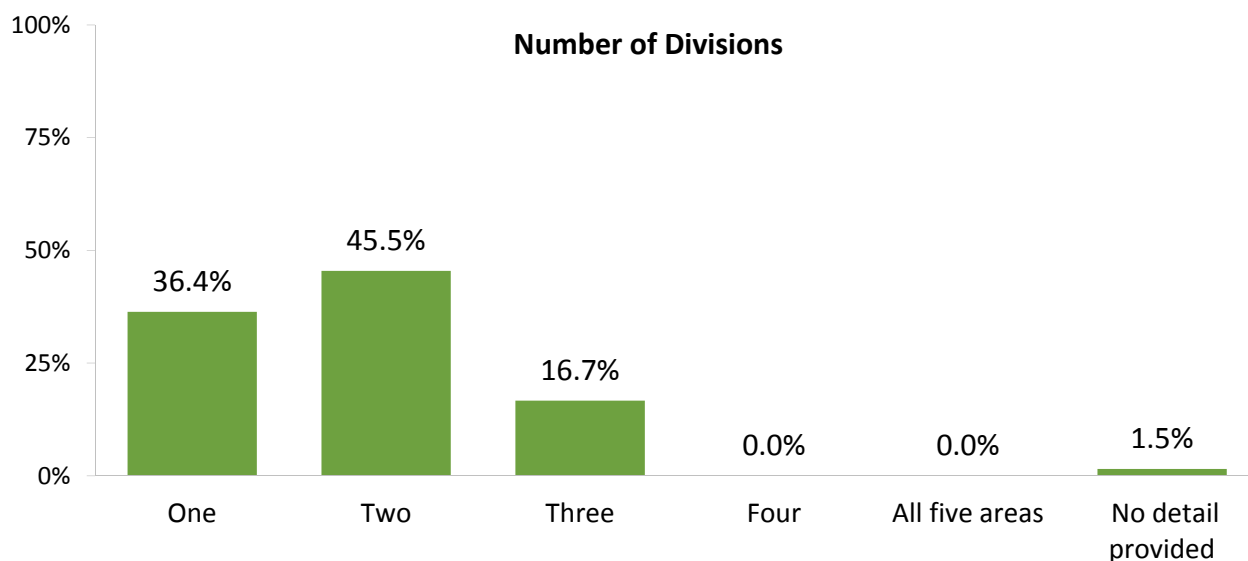

### **Primary Field of Study: Number of Divisions**






First-time, First-year respondents indicated one division of emphasis 36.4% of the time, 45.5% indicated two areas of emphasis, and 16.7% indicated three divisions. There were no First-time, First-year respondents who included four or five areas of emphasis. One respondent gave no further detail about their primary field of study.
