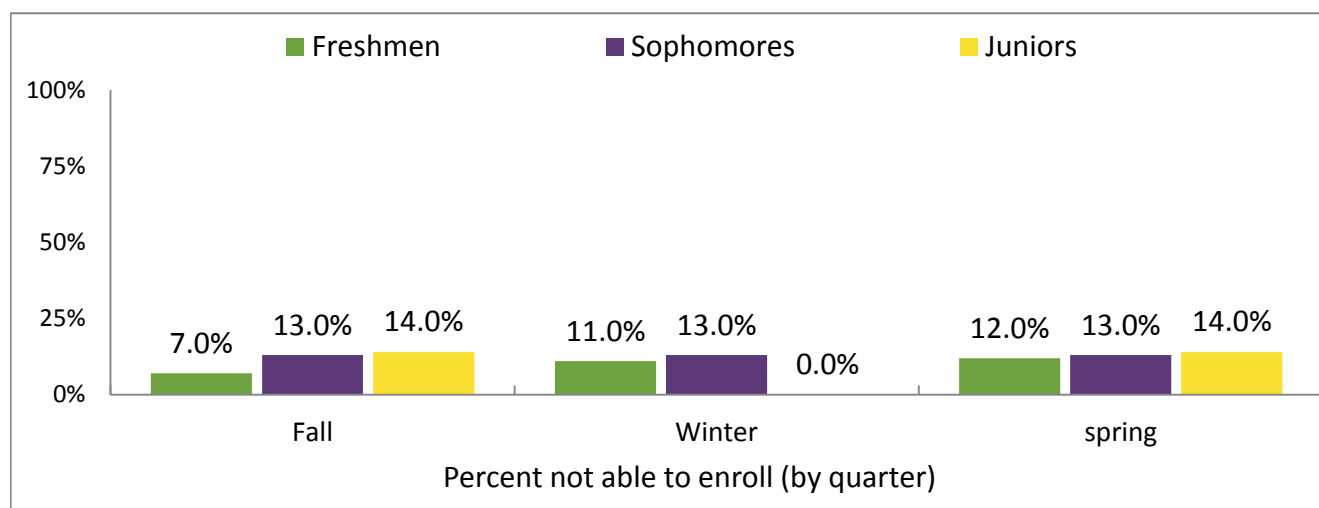


### ***Were you able to enroll in your first choice of academic offerings?***

The percentage of First-time, First-year respondents who indicated that they could not enroll in their first choice of academic offerings ranged from a low of 0% for Juniors in winter to a high of 14% for Juniors in fall and spring.
