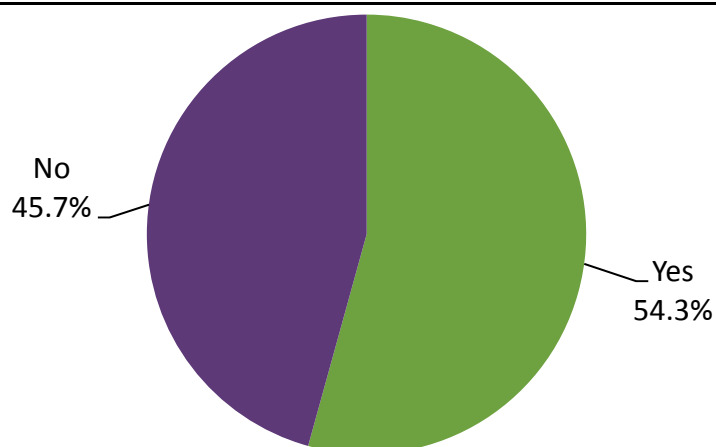


***Did you participate in undergraduate research as part of your academic work this year?***

Students were asked whether they participated in research as part of their academic work this year and whether it was part of a program/course/SOS or Independent Learning Contract (ILC). Most Tacoma Campus respondents indicated that they had participated in academic research (54.3%). Of the respondents who participated in undergraduate research, 68.0% participated during a program/course/SOS, 12.0% participated during an ILC or an Internship, and 4.0% participated during both a program/course/SOS and during an ILC or Internship.

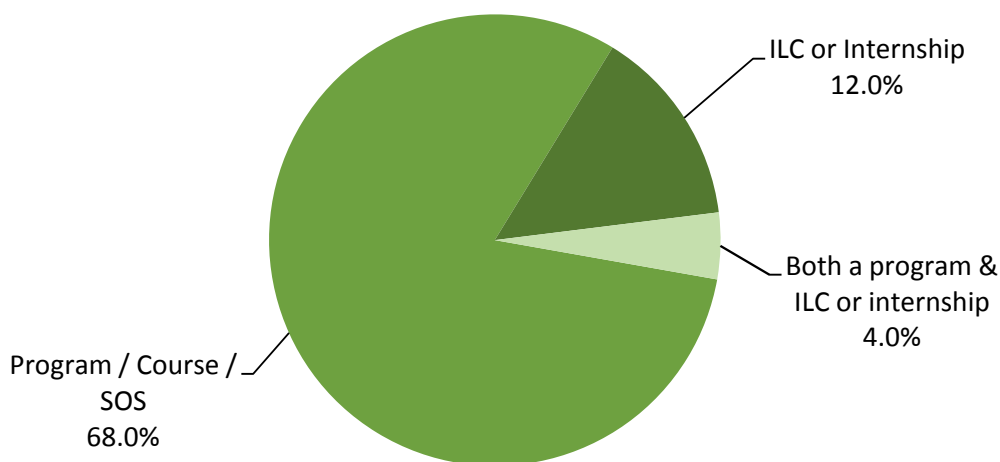
***Did you participate in undergraduate research as part of your academic work this year?***

Respondents who had participated in undergraduate research as part of their academic work were asked what the nature of their project was. 21 Tacoma campus respondents provided an answer. 38% of these respondents mentioned their Spring Fair projects, with topics ranging from youth to urban planning. Other responses included many projects based in the respondent's community, including mental health and emergency preparedness. Four respondents provided no detail about the nature of their project.
