Aggregate Summary Report

Spring quarter Academic Mentoring Day events took place in the Library building as they did during winter quarter. The spring event occurs on the same day as Transfer Advising Day, in which incoming transfers for fall 2015 are encouraged to participate in Mentoring Day sessions. Faculty presenters collected attendance counts for the sessions, which resulted in estimated attendance for Mentoring Day and evening sessions of 165, which compares to attendance of 365 in prior spring 2014 events.
