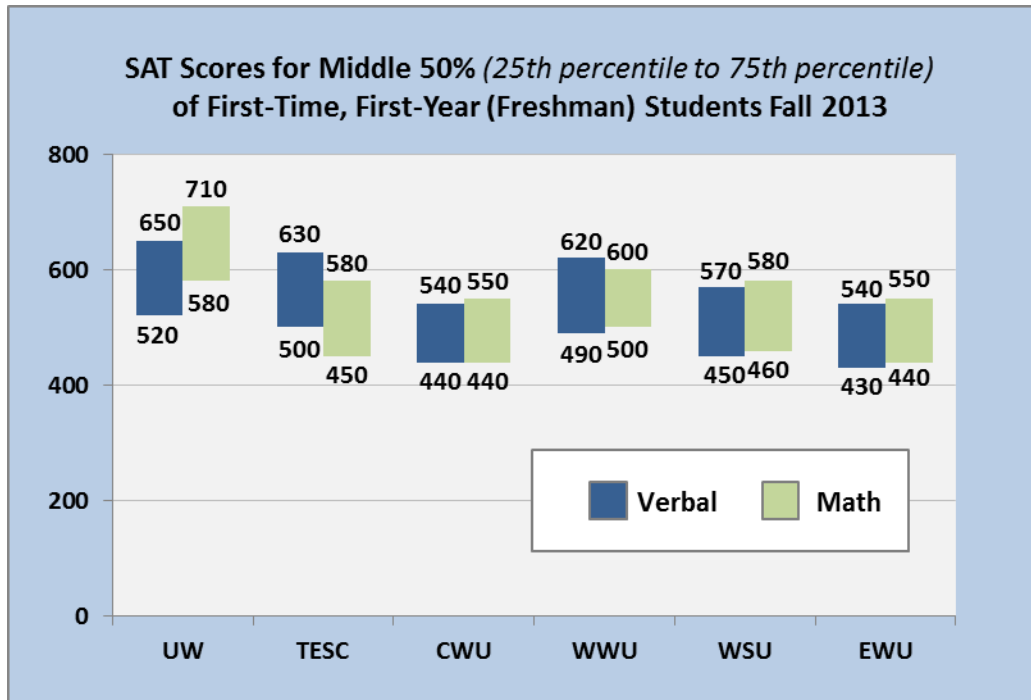


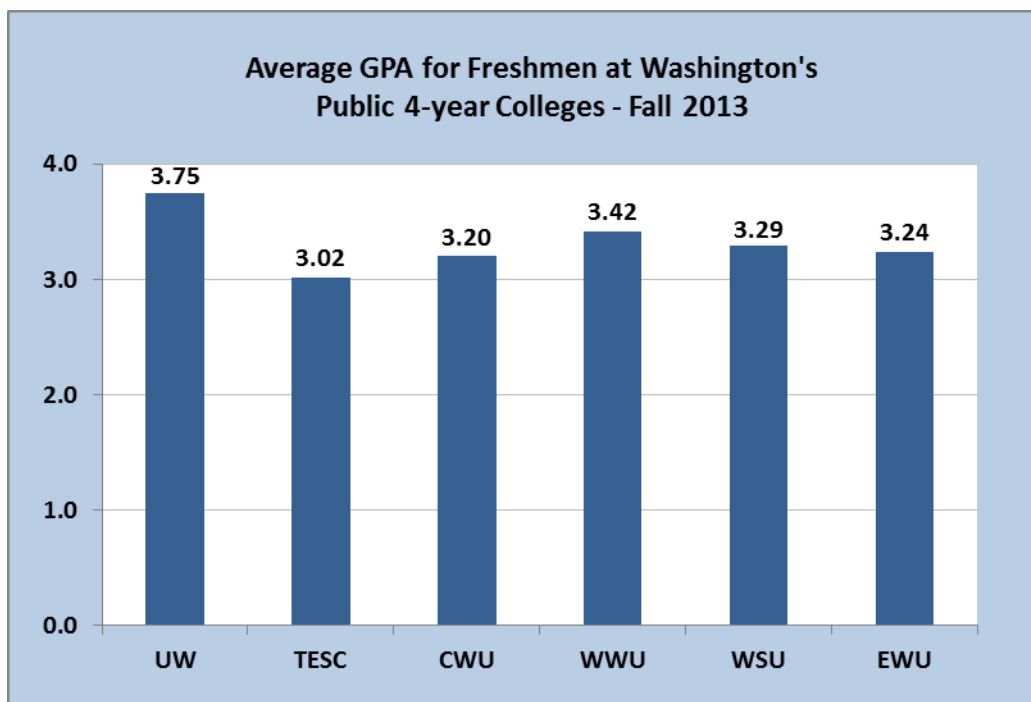
SAT Scores and GPAs for Entering Freshmen at Washington's Public Baccalaureate Institutions

Of the freshmen entering Washington's six public baccalaureate institutions in fall 2013, Evergreen's freshmen scored second only to the UW on the verbal SAT. The middle 50% of our entering class scored between 500 and 630; UW freshmen scored slightly higher with verbal scores between 520 and 650. Evergreen freshmen consistently score at or near the top of this peer group on the verbal SAT. On the math SAT, Evergreen's middle 50% scored between 450 and 580 – higher than CWU and EWU's new freshmen, comparable to those at WSU, and lower than freshmen at UW and WWU. This ranking is also fairly consistent over time, reflecting the reality that as a liberal arts college Evergreen may be more of a magnet for students whose verbal skills are strong relative to their quantitative skills.
