Analysis of First Peoples cohorts

First Peoples students are captured in only one cohort representing their summer cohort.

Overall Assessment of Persistence and Graduation of First Peoples cohort

In this summary analysis, each cohort member has only one current outcome assigned. All outcomes refer to the cohort member status as of Spring quarter 2013. Students who had completed degrees by the end of Spring 2013 are captured as BS or BA completers. Students who are still enrolled at Evergreen are captured as persisting. Cohort members who were no longer enrolled at Evergreen in Spring 2013 are captured as "Left Evergreen."
